



To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

The Petition of the undersigned, inhabitanta of the Township of Adams, s aid county and state, respectfully represent:

That a public road has long since been laid out to lead from a point on the public road leading from Lovett to Palestine beginning at a distance of 1365 ft. Westward along said Lovett-Palestine road from the intersection of the Salix-St. Michael road therewith and ending on the Lamb's Bridge-Salix road at a point 5188.2 ft. Northward from the intersection of the Lovett-Palestine road with the Salix-Lamb's Bridge road.

That a portion of said road, viz: That portion lying between points indicated on the rough sketch hereto attached and made a part of this petition; for the purpose of making more clear and definite the sections of road referred to herein; has for some years past fallen into disuse and disrepair, become dangerous and burdensome and the legal status thereof indefinite and uncertain: Said portion of road thus referred to being that portion represented as lying between points indicated as "A" and "C" on the attached sketch, beginning at the point of beginning of the first above mentioned road and ending at a point located by running in a general Northerly direction for 7391.8 ft. along said abandoned road from the above noted point of beginning indicated as point to the point indicated as "C".
"A"/ This portion of road your petitioners desire vacated.

That a piece of road to begin at point "C" on the attached sketch and herein above definitely located and to end at point indicated as "D" on said sketch and located by beginning at the intersection of the Lovett-Palestine road with the Salix-St.

Michaels road and measuring thence along said last mentioned road in a general Northerly direction 5422 ft. to the Lovett-South Fork road and thence in a North Westerly direction, along said Lovett-South Fork road for 2823.8 ft. to point "D" indicated on said attached sketch; is necessary for the convenience and accommodation

of the traveling public and this piece of road your petitioners desire to have laid out and supplied.

That during the year 1914 the portion of road first above referred to and lying between points "A" and "B" was recommended to be vacated; the no petition requesting its vacation had been presented & no view directly relative thereto had been granted by the Court; yet in 1915 a petition was presented and a view granted asking that the said piece of road, above referred to, as recently vacated be laid out and supplied. The viewers appointed by the fourt upon this petition reported that the said piece of road desired to be supplied was unnecessary and should not be granted.

Therefore your petitioners pray your honorable Court to appoint three members of the permanent board of viewers of Cambria County to view and determine as to the propriety of vacating the aforesaid piece of road requested to be vacated and also to view and determine as to the necessity for laying out and supplying the piece of road hereinabove requested to be supplied, and that they be directed to make a report of their proceedings to the next term of said court.


#### Release of Damages.

WHEREAS, By an Order of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania, dated the day of August, A. D. 1923, directed to A. M. Shoemaker, Mahlon J. Baumgardner and Philip E. Caufield, a certain public road in Adams Township, said county and state, was laid out and recommended to be opened for public use; said road as laid out beginning at a point on the road leading Northward and Westward from the Lovett-Palestine road to the Palestine-Lamb's Bridge road and extending in a Northerly direction to the Lovett-South Fork road ending at a point on said last mentioned road approximately one hundred feet Eastward, along said hovett-South Fork road, from the old Club House, in the Village of St. Michael; which said road as laid out and located extends for its entire distance through and over lands of the Maryland Coal Company, in said township, county and state aforesaid:

THEREFORE, Know all men by these presents: That the said Maryland Coal Company, through and over whose lands said road as laid out is located, for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to them in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and the further consideration of the advantages which may accrue to them by reason of the laying out and opening of said road, they do hereby release the County of Cambria from all damages that have or may result to them by reason of the locating, opening and using of said road by the public for any reason whatsoever.

'E. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth t wan you any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, index of procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all so for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in evel, case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtanied, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the . Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefily the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."

#### REPORT OF VIEWERS.

To the Honorable, the Judges of said Court: -

We, the undersigned Viewers, appointed by the annexed order of the above court, to view the premises for the vacating and supplying of a public road.

That the portion of the road to be vacated begins at a point on the public road leading from Lovett to Falestine a distance of 1365 feet Westward along said Livett-Palestine road from the intersection of the Salix-St Michael road therewith and ending on the Lamb's Bridge-Salix road at a point 5188.2 feet Northward from the intersection of the Lovett-Palestine road with the Salix-Lamb's Bridge road.

And the said road to supply the portion to be vacated as above set forth begins at the point of ending of the road desired to be vacated and ending in the Village of St Michael at a point located by running 2823.8 feet in a North Westerly direction along the Lovett-South Fork road from the juncture of Salix-St Michael road with the said Lovett-South Fork road, respectfully report:-

That we were duly sworn or affirmed as members of the permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County, as shown by the records of said Court, gave due public notice of the time and place of meeting of said Viewers by handbillsposted on the premises and by notice served upon the Commissioners of Cambria County, and upon A. C. Baumgardner and F. P. Miller, a majority of the Board of Supervisors of Adams Township and upon R. M. Mullen for the Maryland Coal Company, a land owner, at least ten days prior to the time of the making of said view, evidence of which is shown by copies of said Notice hereto attached and made a part of this report; that we met upon the premises according to the notice given at the point of beginning first above mentioned, on Tuesday August 21st., A. D. 1923 at 10:30 o'clock A. M. and proceeded with the duties of our appointment.

We viewed the site and locality of the road proposed to be vacated, making a personal inspection of the ground between the points designated in the petition and order.
