

In re petition for the appointment of viewers to assess damages occasioned by the opening of a public road in the Township of East Taylor, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania

I TO THE HONORS, THE JUDGES OF THE COURT OF QUARTER SESSIONS OF THE PEACE IN AND FOR THE COUNTY OF CAMBRIA AND STATE OF PENNSYLVANIA:

The petition of Margaret Cavanaugh Patterson respectfully represents:

That a public road or highway has been laid out and opened within a
one year past through the lands of your petitioner by the order of said Court.

That the aforesaid land is located in the said Township of East Taylor, County and State aforesaid.

That by the laying out, opening, widening and changing of said road as aforesaid your petitioner has sustained great injury and damage, among other things as follows:

- (a) That the said road appropriates a large part of said land.
 - (b) That the said road renders the rest of said land less valuable.
- (c) That the said road makes a deep cut across a large portion of said land, causing said land to be greatly less in value if not wholly destroyed.
- (d) That the said land is rendered by reason of said road less accessible.
- (e) That said land is rendered less valuable by reason of the grade being made different than the abutting land and different than the grade of the former road.
- (f) That the change from the former road to the present location greatly damages your petitioner's said land.

(g) That in various other ways the said land is rendered less valuable by reason of the laying out, opening, widening, changing and construction of said road.

Your petitioner therefore prays your Honors to appoint three disinterested persons to view the premises and assess the damages which your petitioner may have sustained as aforesaid.

That we were duly sworn or affirmed as members of the permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County, as shown by the records of the Court; That due public notice of the time and place of meeting of said Viewers was given by publication in the Johnstown Daily Tribune and in the Cambria County Legal Journal and by hand bills posted upon the premises, and by service upon the Commissioners of Cambria County, upon Charles C. Greer, Esq., Solicitor for the Supervisors of the Township of East Taylor and upon Frank P.
