

REPORT OF VIEWERS.

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions
of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the board of viewers of Cambria county, appointed by your honorable Court upon the attached order and therein directed to view and determine as to the propriety of vacating and supplying a certain portion of the public road in White Township from the juncture of the road leading from St. Lawrence with the Ebensburg-Phillipsburg Pike to the line between the townships of White and Chest, respectfully report:-

That having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers to the Commissioners of Cambria County, the Supervisors of White Township; and having them accept service of notices hereto attached; and to the traveling public by printed hand bills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the terminal points of the piece of road to be viewed: and having been first duly qualified according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the best of our judgment and ability. All of us met in accord with the notices given and having carefully viewed the premises are of the opinion that the piece of road in question; as particularly described on the attached order of court and designated on the plot or draft hereto attached and made a part of this report; should be vacated and a new road laid out to supply that vacated, which in obedience to said order we have done as follows.

Said piece of road proposed to be vacated takes the following courses and distances from the point of beginning at the juncture of the St. Lawrence road with the Ebensburg-Phillipsburg road, in White Township, and extends thence N. $69^{\circ} 15'$ W. 210 ft., S. $62^{\circ} 45'$ W. 213 ft., S. 64° W. 1135.4 ft., N. $37^{\circ} 15'$ W. 410 ft., S. $81^{\circ} 30'$ W. 260 ft., S. 70° W. 697 ft., S. $62^{\circ} 30'$ W. 298 ft., S. 50° W. 648 ft., S. $39^{\circ} 30'$ W. 297 ft., S. 36° W. 265 ft. and S. 59° W. 1395 ft. to the line between the townships of White and Chest. And the new road as laid out and recommended to be supplied extends as follows, from the point of

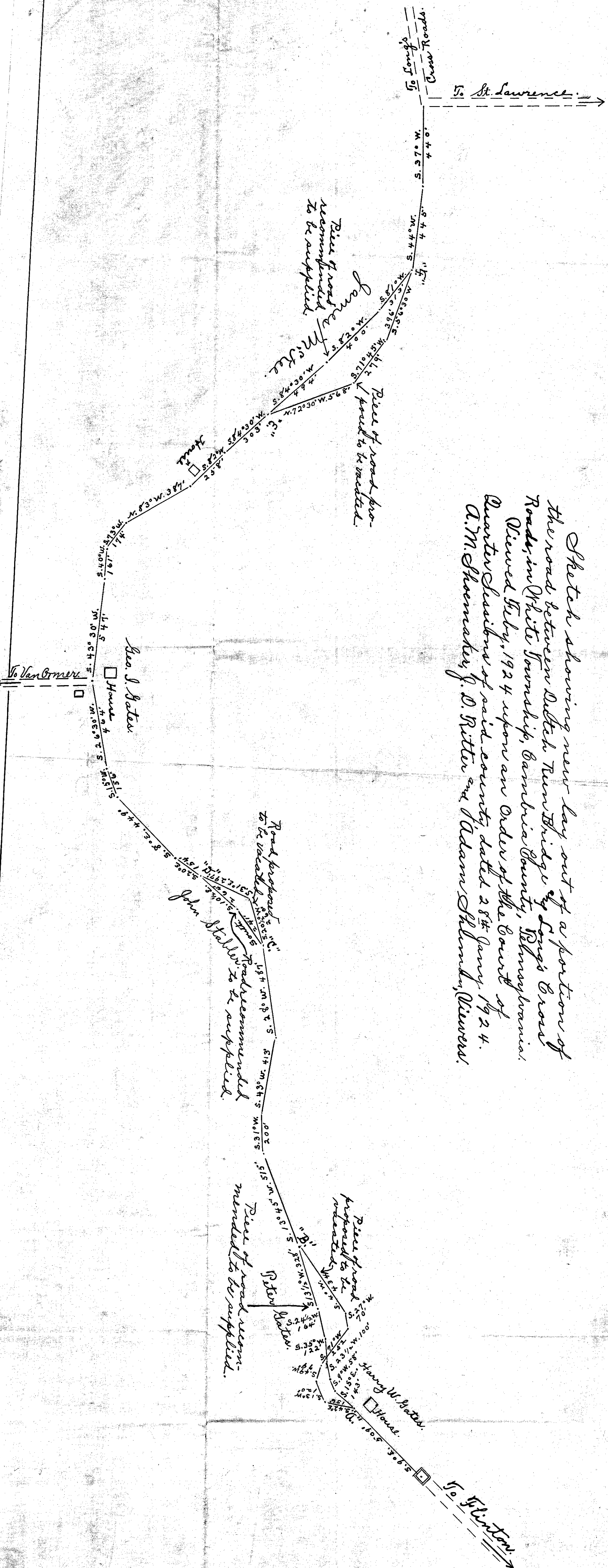
beginning of the piece of road proposed to be vacated, viz: N. 22° 30' W. along the road leading to St. Lawrence, via. Longs Cross Roads, approximately 588 ft. to the point where the new road leading from Frugality adjoins said St. Lawrence road, thence through and over lands of the Disheart Estate (now occupied by Herman Disheart) and James Noel as follows, S. 57° W. 90 ft., S. 60° W. 326 ft., S. 62° W. 560 ft., S. 61° W. 248 ft., S. 69° 30' W. 264 ft., S. 63° W. 242 ft., S. 59° W. 254 ft., S. 50° 15' W. 138 ft., S. 47° W. 172 ft., S. 52° 30' W. 187 ft., S. 59° 30' W. 335 ft., S. 52° W. 285 ft., S. 50° W. 648 ft., S. 39° 30' W. 297 ft., S. 42° 30' W. 401 ft. and S. 59° W. 1249 ft. to the line between the township of White and the township of Chest. Having been unable to secure releases of damages we have assessed the damages to the Disheart Estate at Five Hundred Dollars and the damages to James Noel at Forty Five Dollars.

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Cambria held at Ebensburg, in the said County, on the 28th day of January A. D. 1924, before the Honorable Judge of the said Court: Upon the petition of divers inhabitants of the Township of White, in the said County, setting forth that they labor under inconvenience for want of a road or highway, to lead from

That a public road was long since laid out and opened leading from the road between St. Lawrence and the Ebensburg and Philipsburg pike, at a point 377 feet south from the road leading from Philipsburg to St. Lawrence Road and ending at the line between White Township and Chest Township 6500 feet from the St. Lawrence Road, has become inconvenient, impracticable and burdensome, by reason of numerous sharp curves and steep grades, and the said road would be very much improved by a change of its route between said points.

Your petitioners therefore pray the Court to appoint qualified persons to view the premises and to inquire into the expediency of making such change by vacating in whole or in part the present road and supplying the whole or part of a new road, as directed by the Act of Assembly in such case made and provided.

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. The Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

A. M. Shoemaker, Esq., surveyor, and

viewers, to view the ground proposed for said road, and if they view the same, and shall agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be as far as practicable, agreeable to the desires of the petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which it may pass.

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
