IN THE COURT OF QUARTER SESSIONS OF CAMBRIA COUNTY -

To the Honorable, the Judge of said Court.

We, the undersigned, Commissioners of the Township of Stonycreek, a township of the first class in the county of Cambria and state of Pennsylvania, in pursuance of Section 498 of the Act of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, approved July 14th, 1917 entitled "An Act concerning, and revising, amending and consolidating the law relating thereto, do hereby report that in pursuance of the petition of certain owners of property in said Township of Stonycreek for the lay out of a road between the points therein named, a copy of which said petition, together with the names of the property owners, signing the same, is hereto attached, did give ten (10) days notice to the property owners affected thereby, of a time and place in and where all persons interested might meet and be heard; and after said hearing and consideration of the matter, the undersigned being the majority of the Board of Commissioners do hereby decide in favor of granting the prayer of said petition and do grant the same for public use a road according to the following courses and distances. Beginning at a point on Martha Ave., at the line between Johnstown City and Stony Creek Township and extending thence along said Martha Ave., South 37°-48 East through the plans of lots laid out by R.L. Griffith, Mrs. Mary A. Witt, and Mrs. Sarah M. Arthur, Mr Lowman Griffith, and Mrs. Emma Lenhart to Oakland Ave., and being approximately 1164 feet in length and of a uniform width of 40 feet, a draft or survey of which said road showing the improvements along line thereof, together with the names of the owners of property to which the same shall pass or whereon it shall abut is hereto attached.
