NOTE. "It shall be uty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonweath i water oad or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge in feavor to procure from the person or person so whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtanied, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different countles of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agree-

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and, return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding tive degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."

REPORT OF VIEWERS

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the board of viewers of Cambria County appointed by your honorable Court to view and determine as to the propriety of vacating a certain piece of public road in the township of Clearfield, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, between the terminal points particularly described in the attached order of the Court; respectfully report:-

That having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers to the Commissioners of Cambria County, the Supervisors of the Township of Clearfield; and having them accept service of notices hereto attached; and to the traveling public by printed hand bills posted in public and conspicuous places along the route and near the terminii of the piece of road petitioned to be vacated; having been first duly sworn according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the best of our judgment and ability, all of us met in accord with the notices so given and posted, as aforesaid, and having gone over and carefully viewed the piece of road in question and are unanimously of the opinion that the piece of road between the terminii referred to in said attached order and as indicated on the plot or draft hereto attached and made a part of this report should be vacated.

The piece of road in question and desired to be vacated begins at a point 2455 feet Southward, along the Patton-Chest Springs road, from the line between Patton Borough and the Township of Clearfield; where the original road intersects the new State Highway and extends thence the following courses and distances, viz: North 9° East 303 feet, North 24° 30' East 122 feet, North 26° East 206 feet, North 10° 20' East 135 feet, North 25° 30' East 222 feet, North 24° West 145 feet, North 55° West 177 feet and North 38° 45' West 98 feet to where said original road intersects with the brick road leading from Patton to St. Augustine; passing the properties of Matt. Cohler, John Christoff the

Cemetery,

and others, as indicated of the

attached draft.

The parties living along the piece of road proposed to be vacated, by reason of the new lay out and construction of the improved high-way have easy access to the new State Highway from their own properties and the value of their said properties, in the minds of the viewers, having been enhanced by reason of the change, are not entitled to any damages.

TO THE HONORABLE THE JUDGES OF THE COURT OF QUARTER SESSIONS:

The Petition of the undersigned inhabitants of Clearfield Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, respectfully represents:

That a public road was long since laid out and opened leading from Patton to Chest Springs through Clearfield Township. said road was thereafter taken over by the Department of Highways of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as a State Highway Route No. 221. That the State Highway Commissioner with the approval of the Govenor of the Commonwealth, relocated the said State Highway Route No. 221 and a permanent road has been constructed on the relocated route.

That a part of the original road which begins at a point where the original road intersects the new State Highway, 2455 feet South from the line between Patton Borough and Clearfield Township, and extends in a Northerly direction 1400 feet to a point where the brick road between Patton and St. Augustine intersects the original Highway, has become inconvenient, impracticable and burdensome by reason of the fact that there is an improved State Highway running almost parallel with the road desired to be vacated, and the said road is no longer necessary for the traveling public.

Your petitioners therefore pray your Honorable Court to appoint qualified persons to view the premises and vacate said road in whole or in part, as directed by the Act of Assembly in such case made and And your Petitioners will ever pray, etc. provided.
