IN THE COURT OF QUARTER SESSIONS OF CAMBRIA COUNTY.

TO THE HONORABLE THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The Commissioners of Cambria County respectfully represent:

That a Township Road starting at the Village of Beaverdale in Summerhill Township on the line between Summerhill and Adams Townships; thence through Adams Township for a distance of 4850 feet to the line between Croyle and Adams Townships; thence through Croyle Township for a distance of 6618 feet, or a total length of 11,468 feet, to the improved Township road in the Village of Lovett, is in a bad state of repair and needs to be improved in order to complete a hard-surface road from Beaverdale through to South Fork, Johnstown and other points.


That the Townships of Adams and Croyle are financially unable to undertake this improvement.

That by resolution dated the 19th day of November, 1924, a copy of which is hereto attached and made a part hereof, your Petitioners took over, subject to the approval of the Court and Grand Jury, the above described road, for the purpose of improving the same and maintaining it as a County road.

That subject to the approval of the Court and Grand Jury your Petitioners propose to improve said road by constructing a one-course re-inforced concrete pavement nine inches thick on the sides and six inches thick in the center to a width of sixteen feet, according to plans and specifications which are hereto attached and made a part of this Petition.

That the estimated cost of said road, as determined by Lewis R. Owen, County Engineer, is \$118,882.70.

Your Petitioners, showing these matters, respectfully ask the court for authority to make said improvements and to fix Friday, December 5th, as the time for hearing of this matter before the Grand Jury.

Homer C. George offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:
