

We, the undersigned, being the members of the Board of Supervisors of Lower Yoder Township, Capbria County, Pennsylvania, do hereby day of April, 1927, a resocertify that on the lution, of which the following is a true copy, was unanimously passed at a meeting of said Board:

"On motion of John Luther, seconded by W. B. Brallier, it was unanimously resolved, That Center Street, extending from its intersection with the westerly side of J Street to its intersection with the easterly side of First Street, with a uniform width of forty (40) feet, as shown on the Plan of Lots of the Elizabeth Burkhard Estate, as laid out January 23, 1913, by the Fetterman Engineering Company, which said Flan is duly recorded in the Recorder's Office of Cambria County, Pa., be and the same is hereby accepted as a public highway or thoroughfare of the Township of Lower Yoder, Cambria County, Pennsylvania."

Re: Acceptance of Center Street in Lower Yoder Township, Cambria County, Pa., as a Township Road

The petition of James Edwards, John Luther and W. B. Brallier respectfully represents:

- (1) That they are the members of the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Lower Yoder, Cambria County, Pa.
- (2) That on the fourth day of April, 1927, the said Board of Supervisors unanimously enacted a resolution accepting a part of Center Street in said Township as a public highway or thoroughfare of said Township, a certified and attested copy of said resolution being hereto attached.
- (3) That the part of Center Street accepted as aforesaid is more than thirty-three (33) feet in width.
