

To the Honorable the Judges of the above named Court:

The petition of James Edwards, John Luther and W. B. Brallier respectfully represents:

- (1) That they are the members of the Board of Supervisors of the Town-ship of Lower Yoder, Cambria County, Pa.
- (2) That on the _______ day of November, 1927, the said Board of Supervisors unanimosuly enacted a Resolution accepting a part of Second Street in said Township as a public highway or thoroughfare of said Township, a certified and attested copy of said Resolution being hereto attached.
- (3) That the part of Second Street accepted as aforesaid is more than thirty-three (33) feet in width.
- (4) That under the Act of Assembly approved the 22nd day of March, 1927 (P. L. No.37), it is necessary that the consent of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pa., be given to the acceptance of said street as a part of the public highway system of said township.

Wherefore, your petitioners pray that an order and decree be made by your Honorable Court approving and assenting to the acceptance of said Second Street as a public highway of the said Township of Lower Yoder.

We, the undersigned, being the members of the Board of Supervisors of Lower Yoder Township, Cambria County, Pa., do hereby certify that on the 10 day of November, 1927, a Resolution, of which the following is a true copy, was unanimously passed at a meeting of said Board:

"On motion of W. B. Brallier, seconded by John Luther, it was unanimously resolved, That Second Street, extending from its intersection with the northerly line of Center Street to its intersection with the southerly line of Burkhard Street, with a uniform width of forty (40) feet, as shown on the Plan of Lots of the Elizabeth Burkhard Estate, as laid out January 23, 1913, by the Fetterman Engineering Company, which said Plan is duly recorded in the Recorder's Office of Cambria County, Pa., be and the same is hereby accepted as a public highway or thoroughfare of the Township of Lower Yoder, Cambria County, Pennsylvania".
