

To the Honorable the Judges of the above named Court:

The pstition of James Edwards, John Luther and W. B. Brallier respectfully represents:

- (1) That they are the members of the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Lower Yoder, Cambria County, Pa.
- (2) That on the day of November, 1927, the said Board of Supervisors unanimously enacted a Resolution accepting a part of Orchard Street in said Township as a public highway or thoroughfare of said Township, a certified and attested copy of said Resolution being hereto attached.
- (3) That the part of Orchard Street accepted as aforesaid is more than thirty-three (33) feet in midth.
- (4) That under the Act of Assembly approved the 22nd day of March, 1927 (P. L. No. 37), it is necessary that the consent of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pa., be given to the acceptance of said street as a part of the public highway system of said township.

Wherefore, your petitioners pray that an order and decree be made by your Honorable Court approving and assenting to the acceptance of said Orchard Street as a public highway of the said Township of Lower Yoder.
