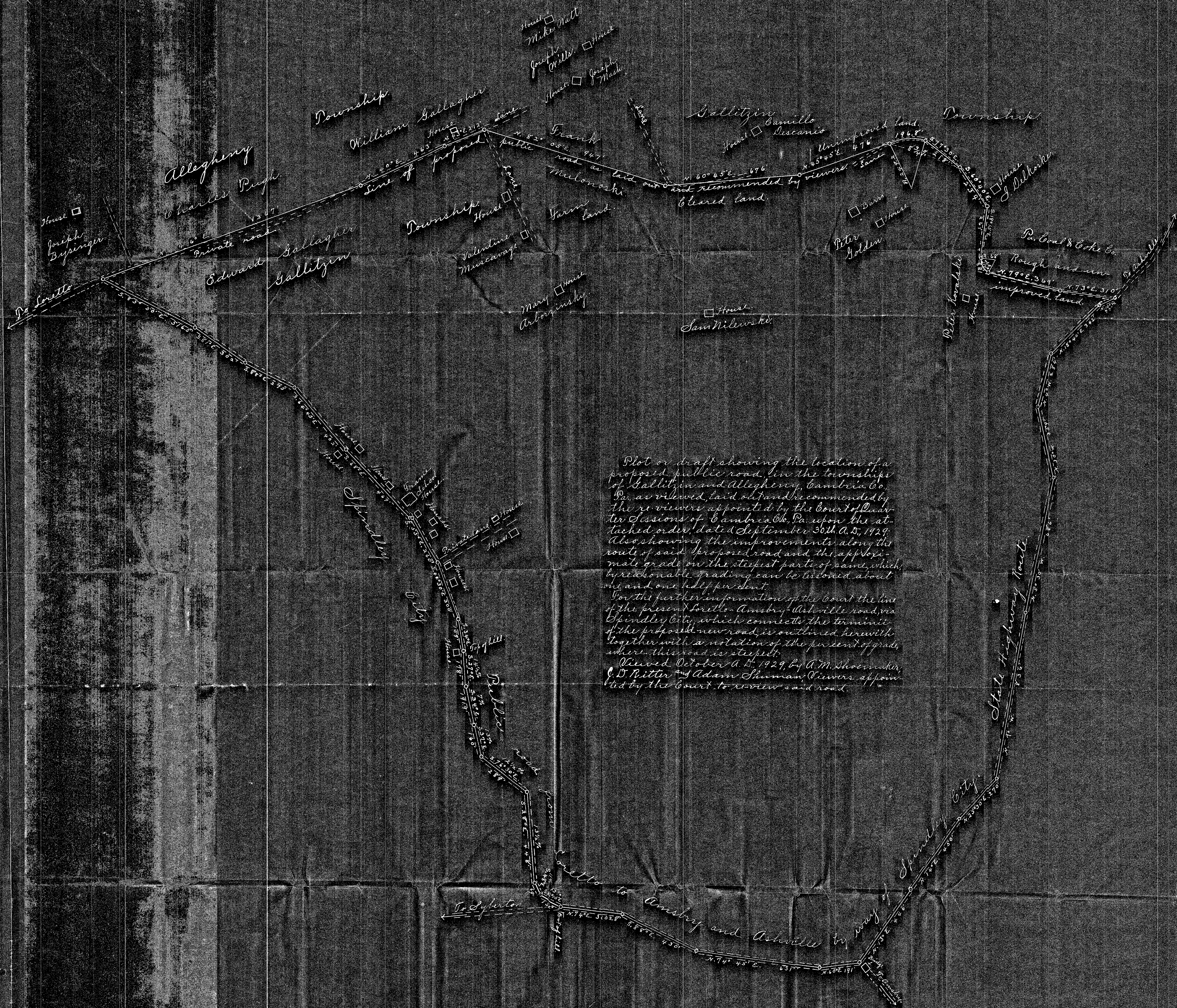

R E P O R T O F V I E W E R S .

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of
Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the Permanent Board of Viewers appointed by your honorable Court to re-view a certain piece of public road, recently laid out but not yet opened, beginning on the line between the townships of Allegheny and Gallitzin and ending at a point on the Syberton - Ashville road, in Gallitzin Township, respectfully report:-

That having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers, appointed to review the said proposed piece of public road, to the Commissioners of Cambria County and to the Supervisors of the townships of Gallitzin and Allegheny, and having them each accept service of notices hereto attached, and to the traveling public by printed hand bills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the termini of the piece of road to be viewed; and each of us having been first duly sworn according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the best of our judgment and ability: All of us met at the time and place appointed, in accord with the notices so given and posted, as aforesaid, and having gone over and carefully reviewed the piece of road in question and are all of the opinion that a new road, between the terminal points specified in the attached order of the Court is necessary for the convenience and accommodation of the traveling public and those citizens of the said townships who reside in the vicinity thereof.

In going over the road as laid out the viewers have concluded that a few slight changes in the location of the proposed new road will improve the alignment of the ~~proposed~~ new road and at the same time accommodate the public perhaps better and those living in the vicinity thereof almost equally as well with slight damage to one property owner over whose land same passes and to whom we have assessed damages as hereinafter stated.

The proposed new road as laid out by the re-viewers takes the following courses and distances, viz: Beginning at the Westerly terminii, as specified on the attached order, on the public road leading from Amsbry to Loretto by way of Spindley City where said road meets the Allegheny Township line and extending thence; as indicated on the plot or draft hereto attached and made a part of this report; North 46° East 1367 feet, North 40° East 463 feet, North 43° East 212 feet, North 82° 05' East 947 feet, North 60° 45' East 676 feet, North 45° 45' East 476 feet, thence turning to the right with a radius of 249.2 feet for a distance of 196.8 feet, thence South 77° 30' East 218 feet, South 60° 40' East 234 feet, South 18° 15' East 261 feet, thence turning to the left with a radius of 68 feet for a distance of 82 feet, thence North 79° East 369 feet and North 73° East 310 feet to the north easterly termini, mentioned in said attached order, on the Syberton - Ashville road.

On the attached draft the relative location of the proposed new road and also the present road between the terminii via Spindley City and a comparison of the grade may be noted.

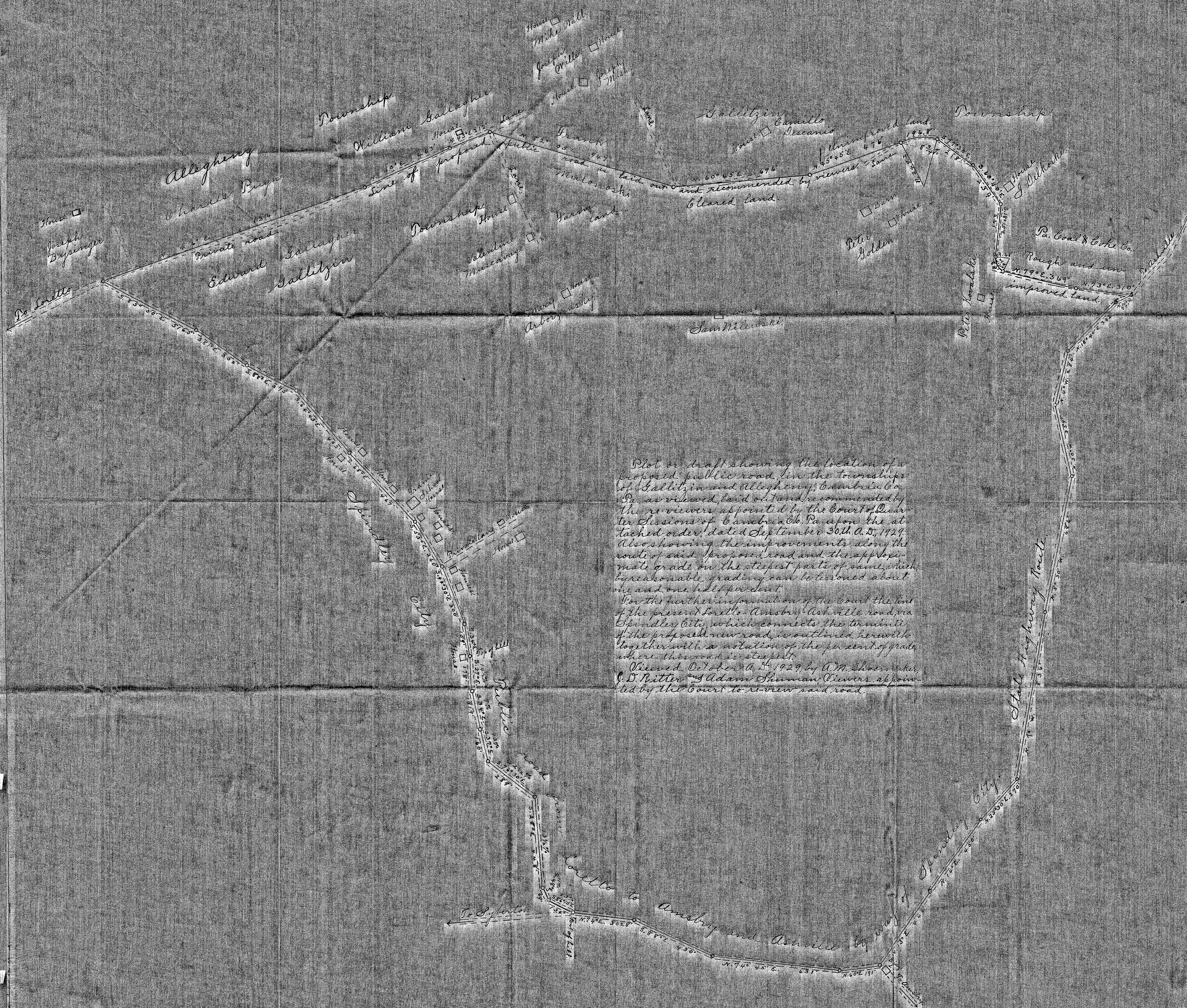

: ROAD DOCKET.

The petition of the undersigned supervisors, citizens, residents, taxpayers, land owners and inhabitants of the Township of Allegheny, in the County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, respectfully represents:

1. That upon the petition of certain inhabitants of the Township of Allegheny, in said County, this Honorable Court appointed viewers to view and lay out a public road as prayed for in said petition.

2. That the viewers appointed by this Honorable Court were A. M. Shoemaker, J. D. Ritter and Adam Shuman.

3. That the said viewers appointed by the Court filed their report on the 8th day of March, 1929, wherein they recommended the opening and construction of the road prayed for.

4. That on the 10th day of June, 1929, the report of said viewers was approved by the Court and the breadth of the road was fixed at forty (40) feet.

5. Your petitioners aver that the opening of said proposed road is not necessary and should not have been recommended by the said viewers, and that the report of said viewers should be set aside for the following reasons:

(a) The road as laid out, and as approved by the Court on June 10th, 1929, is not necessary for the accommodation of the public.

(b) The public and persons living in the vicinity of said road are not inconvenienced and suffer no hardship in case said road is not opened for public travel.

(c) The inhabitants living along the route of said proposed new road all have access to their residences and lands over other public and private highways.

(d) The construction of said proposed road is an unreasonable and undue burden upon the taxpayers of said township.

(e) The proposed road as located is impracticable in that the grades thereon are too steep for public travel by automobiles and other vehicles.

(f) The location of said road is in part over swampy and rough land so that the opening and construction of said road would be prohibitive and the upkeep thereof would be a burden upon the taxpayers of said township.

(g) There is another public road practically paralleling the proposed new road, which old road is adequate and sufficient for the accommodation of the traveling public generally, and for the accommodation and convenience of the inhabitants residing along and in the vicinity of the proposed new road.

WHEREFORE, your petitioners respectfully pray this Honorable Court to appoint re-viewers for the purpose of reviewing the said proposed road and make report thereof to this Court.

And they will ever pray.

And now, Sept. 30, 1929, A. M. Shoemaker, J. D. Ritter and Adam Shuman appointed reviewers as direction to report at the next term of Court.

R E P O R T O F V I E W E R S .

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of
Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the Permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County, appointed by your honorable Court upon the attached order and therein directed to view and determine as to the necessity for a public road between the termini therein specified, respectfully report:

That having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers to the Commissioners of Cambria County, to the Supervisors of the Townships of Gallitzin and Allegheny; and having them accept service of notices hereto attached; and to the Pennsylvania Coal and Coak Company, through and over whose land the proposed road as laid out by the Viewers passes, and to the traveling public by printed hand bills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the termini of the proposed new road and having each been first duly sworn according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the best of our judgment and ability:

All of us met at the time and place appointed, in accord with the notices so given and served as aforesaid, and having gone over the ground carefully; noting the improvements along the line of the proposed new road, the grade and the access the various parties would have to same and the fact that the road would do very little damage to private property, would not be an expensive piece of road to construct and would be a very great benefit to the petitioners and some benefit to the general public, and we are all of the opinion that the prayer of the petitioners should be granted and the road opened for public use.

The road as laid out; a plot or draft of which is hereto attached and made a part of this report; and which we are of the opinion is necessary for a public road, takes the following courses and distances, viz:

Beginning on the Gallitzin - Ashville road at the North Easterlytermini of the proposed new road thence, through and over land of the Pennsylvania Coal and Coke Company, South 73° West 310 feet, South 69° West 369 feet and North 46° 15' West 97 feet, thence through and over land of

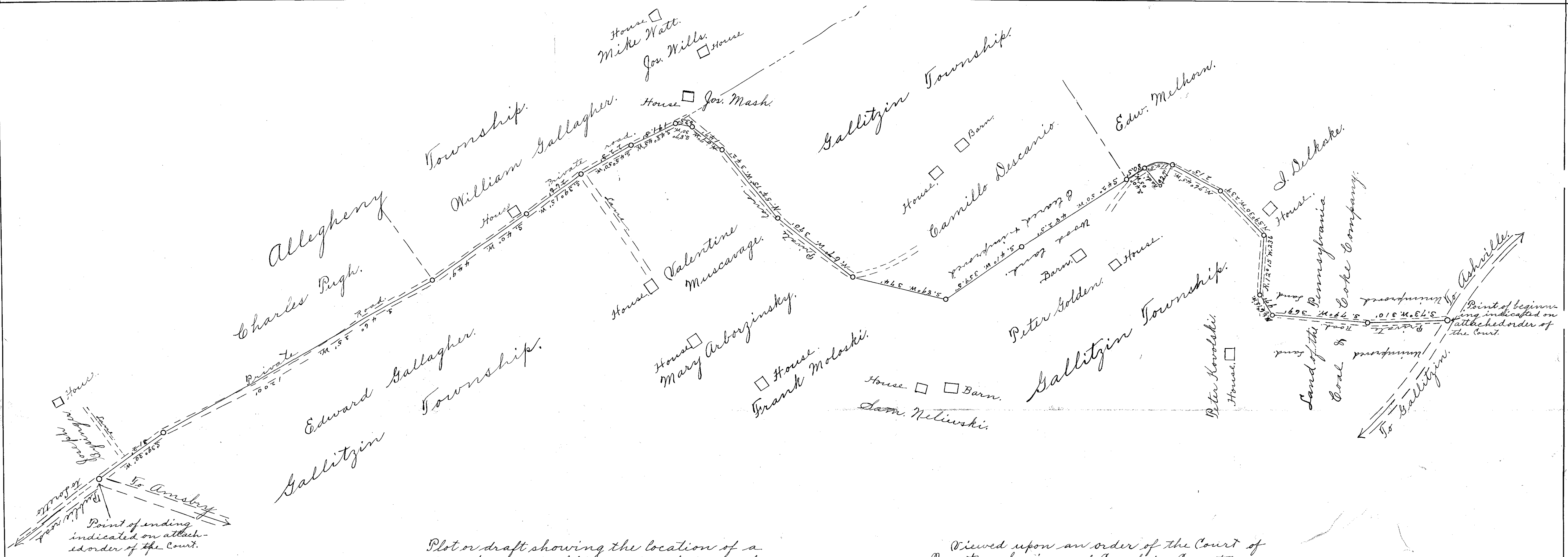

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Cambria held at Ebensburg, in the said County, on the 1st day of April A. D. 192⁹, before the Honorable Judge of the said Court: Upon the petition of divers inhabitants of the Township of Gallitzin and Allegheny in the said County, setting forth that they labor under inconvenience for want of a public road or highway, ~~to lead from~~ beginning in the township of Gallitzin, at a point in the township road leading from Amsbry to Loretto by the way of Spindley City about 3500 feet West of intersection of said road with State Highway Route Number 276, leading from Ashville to Gallitzin; and ending at a point intersecting State Highway Route No. 5000, feet North of Junction of State Highway Route Number 276, with the Amsbry Loretto township road aforementioned. being about one and one-half miles in length.

Your petitioners further aver that a number of families in this vicinity are without any public or private road and are compelled to trespass upon private property in order to get to and from work and church, and that there is no public or private highway by which many of the children can reach a public school.

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. The Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

viewers, to view the ground proposed for said road, and if they view the same, and shall agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be as far as practicable, agreeable to the desires of the petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which it may pass.
