R E P O R T O F V I E W E R S .

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions
of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the Permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County, Pa., appointed by your honorable Court and upon the attached order directed to view and determine as to the propriety of vacating a certain piece of public road in Cambria Township, said county and state, respectfully report:

That having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers to the Commissioners of Cambria County and to the Supervisors of the Township of Cambria by serving notices upon them and to the traveling public by printed hand bills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the termini and along the route of the piece of road proposed to be vacated: All of us met at the time and place appointed, in accord with the notices served and posted as aforesaid, and having each been first duly sworn according to law, to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the best of our judgment and ability; we proceeded to go over and view the piece of road in question and are unanimously of the opinion that same has become useless, inconvenient and burdensome to the taxpayers of the township of Cambria to maintain as a public road and therefore should be vacated, as such, but beg leave to suggest that in our opinion the said piece of road should be left open as a private road particularly for the use and convenience of pedestrians going between the Borough of Ebensburg and Lloyd's Cemetery as it is a much shorter distance and much safer for persons walking than for them to go around, over the improved highway, along the much used traffic route between Ebensburg and Loretto.

The piece of road above referred to ; beginning at the easterly termini of High Street, of Ebensburg Borough; takes the following courses and distances; as indicated on the plot or draft hereto attached and made a part of this report; viz: south 84° east 126 feet, north 69° east 178 feet, south 81° east 85 feet, south

62° east 481 feet, south 74° east 67 feet, north 82° east 100 feet, north 72° east 100 feet, and north 62° east 275 feet to the easterly termini designated on the attached order of Court.

The undersigned viewers further beg leave to suggest that those now responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of the piece of road petitioned to be vacated should; before the consumation of these proceedings; either clean out the channel and place a substantial foot bridge over the small stream indicated on the attached draft or put in some reasonably permanent type of conduits, to prevent the caving in and choking up of the stream at this point which would in all probability dam back the water on the property adjacent to the north side of the road proposed to be vacated, to the inconvenience and detriment of the owner thereof.

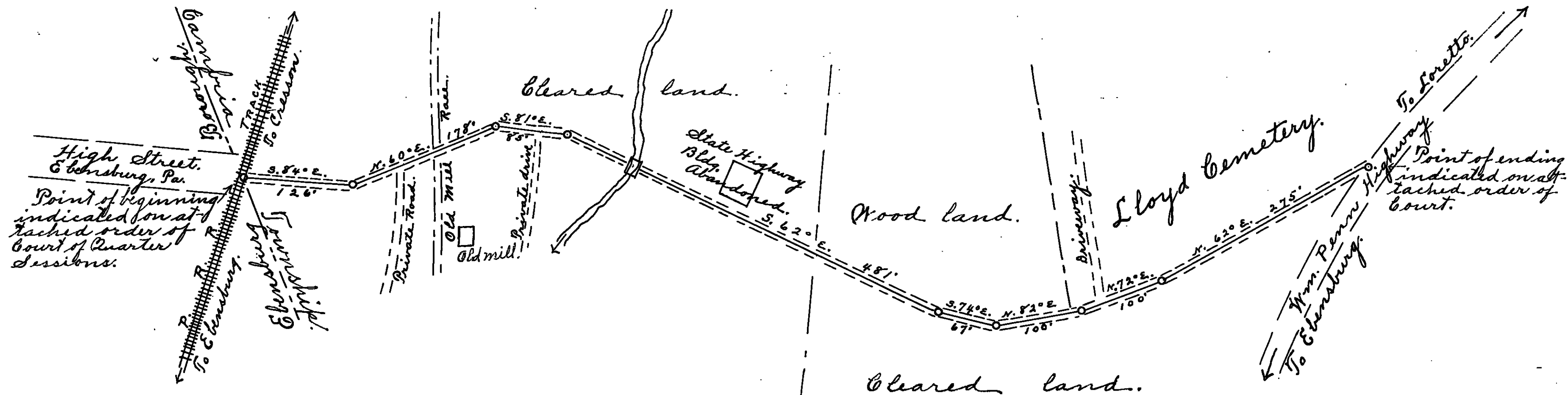

they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County,
stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with
a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through
which it may pass.

NOT. It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
