{ PETITION TO TRANSFER ROAD

TO THE HONORABLE; THE JUDGES OF THE SAID COURT:

The Petition of the undersigned, Commissioners of Cambria County,
respectfully represents:

I. That a section of one of the Cambria County roads, known as the
Cresson Pike Highway, is located in Munster Township as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the Cambria and Munster Township line at the
eastern side of said Cambria Township; thence through said Munster Township to
the boundary line of Munster and Cresson Townships, a distance of approximately
three and three-fourths (3-3/4) miles, more or less.

2. That the section of said road is part of a main highway, known
as the Cresson Pike Highway, and is an improved brick and concrete road.

3. That it is the desire of the County that an effort be made to
have the State of Pennsylvania take over this section of highway, but the petitioners
are informed that the State will take over only sections of roads which are
township roads.

4. That there are other parts of this County road running through
the Townships of Cambria and Cresson and petitions will be filed for the purpose
of transferring said sections of said road from the County to the other two
townships.

WHEREFORE, Your Petitioners pray that the portion or section of said
Cresson Pike Highway which lies within Munster Township may be taken over by and
transferred to the Township of Munster for the purpose of having the State of
Pennsylvania take over the entire Cresson Pike Highway situate in Cambria County
running through the three Townships of Munster, Cambria and Cresson, and they will
ever pray
