RIPORT OF VIEWERS.

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Jessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

Te, the undersigned members of the Perment Board of Viewers of Cambria County, Pa. appointed by your honorable Court upon the attached order and therein directed to view and determine as to the propriety of vacating a certain piece of public road in Cambria and Munster Townships, between the terminic particularly specified in said attached order, respectfully report:
