## REPORT OF VIETERS.

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

re, the undersigned members of the Permanent Board of Vieners of Cambria County, appointed by your honorable Court and upon the attached order directed to view and determine as to the propriety of vacating a certain piece of public road beginning in Huntownship ster/and ending in Cresson Township, said county and state, respectfully report:

That having given due and legal notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers to the Commissioners of Cambria County and to the Supervisors of the Townships of Munster and Cresson and to the traveling public by printed hand bills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the terminii of the piece of road proposed to be vacated; and each having been first duly sworn according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the best of our judgment and ability, all of us met at the time and place appointed in accord with the notices served and posted as aforesaid, and having gone over and carefully viewed the piece of road proposed to be vacated; We are all of the opinion that the piece of road in question is no longer necessary for the accommodation of the traveling public, as a public road, and therefore recommend that the same be vacated.

The portion of said road lying between points indicated on the draft, hereto attached and made a part of this report, between points indicated by the letters "A" and "B" we recommend should be left open as a private road for the accommodation of those having occasion to use same.

The piece of road recommended to be vacated, beginning on the old Ebensourg - Cresson Pike ( or the Pittsburgh - Philadelphia Turnpike ) at a point approximately 1823 feet westward, along said old Pike, from its intersection with the Cresson - Blacklick Bran-

ch of the P. R. R., in Munster Township, and extends thence M. 19° 20' E. 954 feet., N. 8° E. 586 feet, N. 17° E. 642 ft., M. 18° E. 869 ft., P. 15° 30' E. 1267 ft., R. 5° 30' E. 539 ft., F. 16° E. 269 ft., M. 7° E. 295 ft., M. 10° E. 305 ft., M. 37° E. 223 ft., Morth 52° E. 185 ft. to the adjoining road in Cresson Township, leading westward from the Loretto - Cresson road.

About two fifths of the northerly portion of the above described road have fallen into disuse and disrepair and at places would be dangerous to travel. A bridge over a small stream close to the northerly end of the described road has out for a considerable length of time. There are no occupied farms beyond the point recommended to be left open for a private road and the viewers are unable to see any occasion and there seems to be no desire on the part of any of the citizens of either of the aforesaid townships that the road should be left as a public road and we are unable to see that same would be of any use to the general public.
