NOTE, "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fall to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtanied, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

We, the undersigned members of the Permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County, appointed by your honorable Court and upon the attached order directed to view and determine as tomthe advisibility of vacating and supplying a certain piece of public road in Jackson Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, lying between the public road leading from the William Penn Highway, at Ford's Corner, to Twin Rocks, and the public road leading from the same highway, at Mundy's Corner, to Nanty-Glo; as is more definitely and particularly described in the order of Court, hereto attached, respectfully report.
