PETITION TO TRANSFER ROAD

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE SAID COURT:

The Petition of the undersigned, Commissioners of Cambria County,  
respectfully represents:

1. That a section of one of the Cambria County roads, known as the  
Vintondale-Twin Rocks road, is located in Jackson Township as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on Route No. 45 at Twin Rocks Station on the  
Pennsylvania Railroad in the Township of Jackson; thence in a westerly direction  
through the Township of Jackson to a point on the Northeastern boundary line of  
the Borough of Vintondale, a distance of 2.2 miles, more or less.

2. That the section of said road is part of a main highway known as  
the Vintondale-Twin Rocks Road, and is an improved brick and concrete road.

3. That it is the desire of the County that an effort be made to have  
the State of Pennsylvania take over this section of highway, but the petitioners  
are informed that the State will take over only sections of roads which are  
township roads.

WHEREFORE, Your Petitioners pray that the portion or section of said  
Vintondale-Twin Rocks road which lies in Jackson Township may be taken over by  
and transferred to the Township of Jackson for the purpose of having the State of  
Pennsylvania take over the entire Vintondale-Twin Rocks road situate in Cambria  
County running through Jackson Township, and they will ever pray.
