"It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtanied, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions, of Cambria County, Pannsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the Permanent Board of Viewers, of Cambria County, appointed by your Honorable Court to view and report on the advisability of opening as a public road a certain piece of road adjoining the Village of Jamestown, in Portage Township, Cambria County, do respectfully report:-That having given due notice to the Commissioners of Cambria Countyand to the Supervisors of Portage Township by serving on them copies of the attached notice and also giving notice to the citizens of the district by posting notices on the route of the proposed new road and having been previously sworn accor\_ ding to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully and impartially and to the best of our ability and judgment the viewers met at the time and place designated in the notices posted in the Village of Jamestown, on Monday, June 5th., at IO:30, a.m.; to perform the duties of their appointment.
