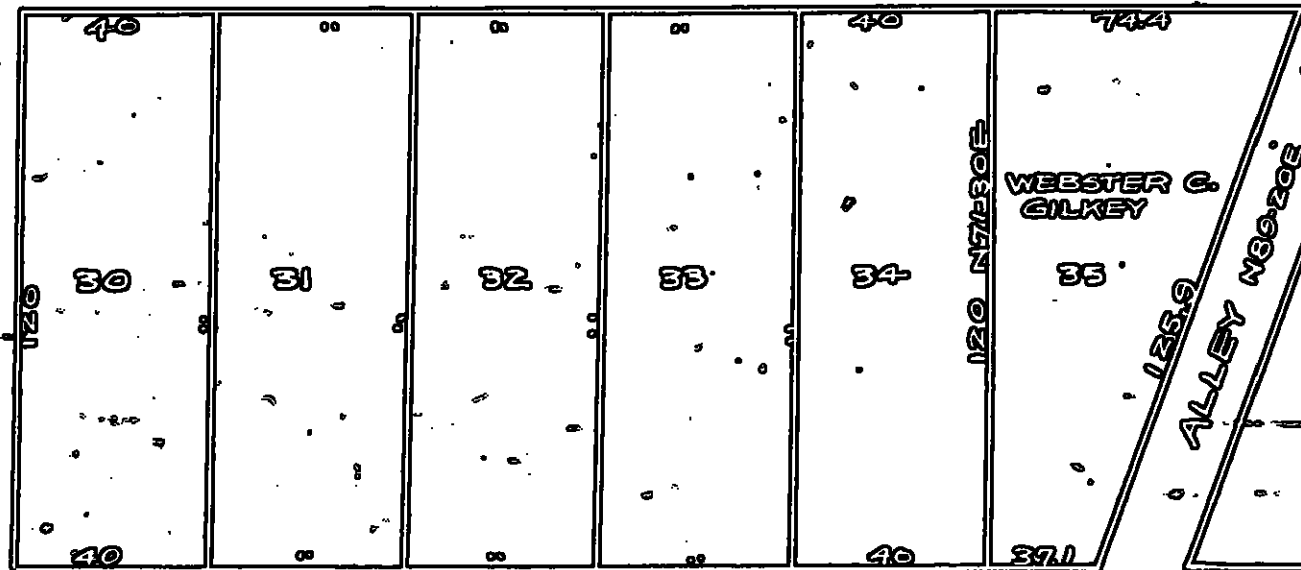

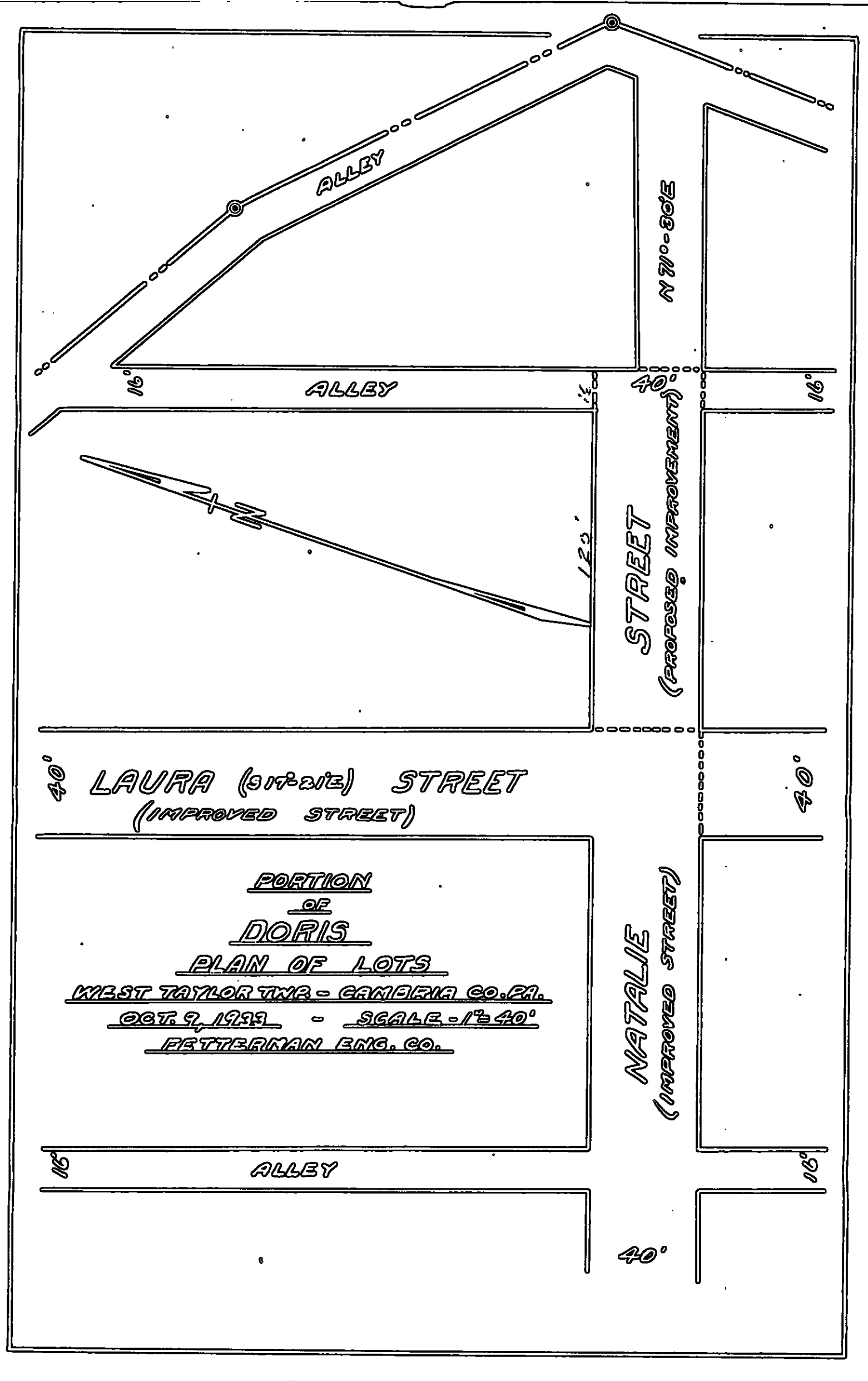


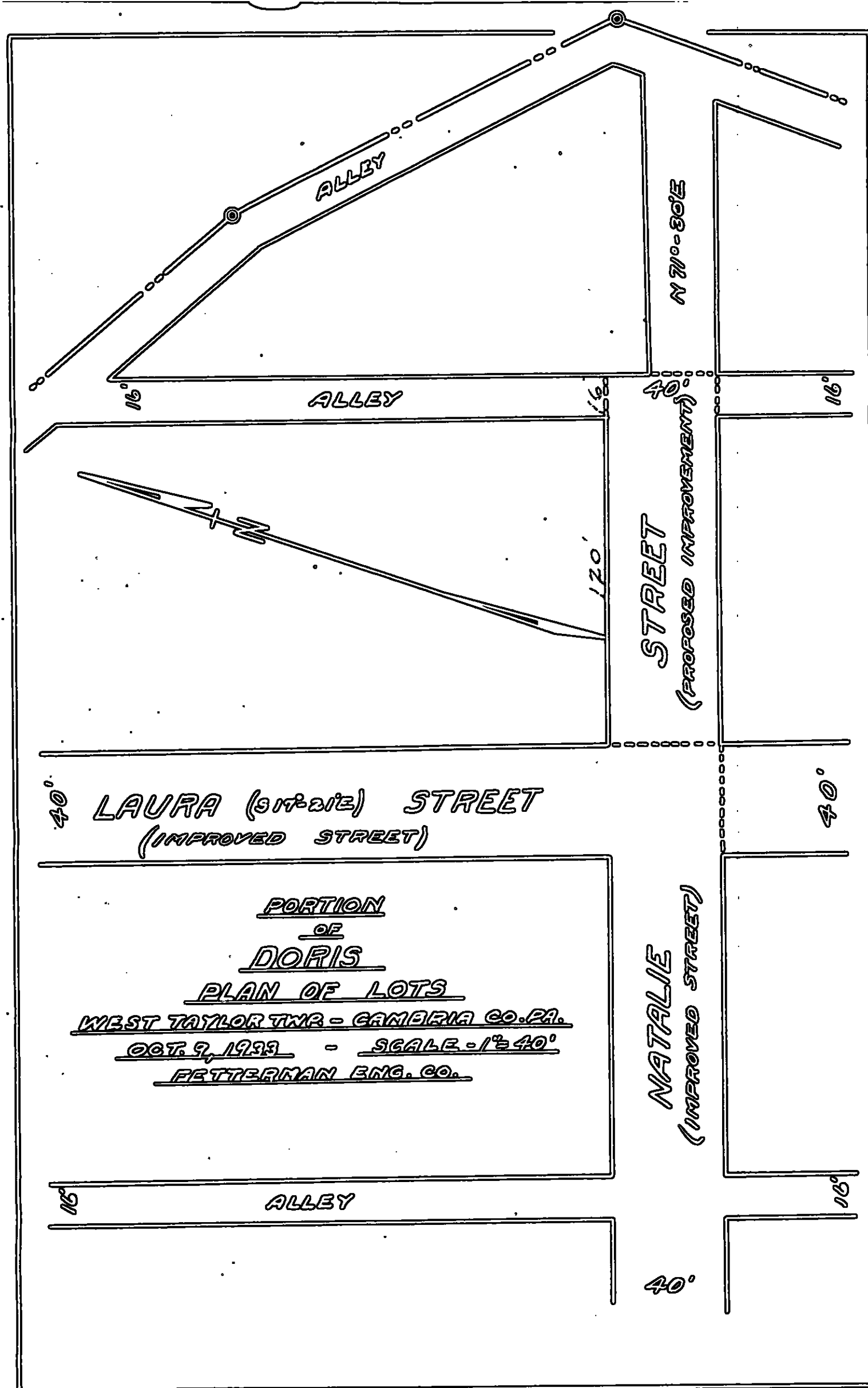
ALLEY
