

To the Honorables, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of
Cambria County, Pennsylvania:

The petition of Frank H. Wyland, of Clearfield Township, Cambria
County, Pennsylvania, respectfully represents:

That he is the owner of a certain piece or parcel of land sit-
uate in Clearfield Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, adjoining
lands of Francis Hertzog, Henry Noel Estate, Oliver Delozier, Joseph
Yahner, and others, containing about seventy eight acres, more or less.
That a Highway, now known as State Highway Route No. 406 passes through
said farm.

That during the year 1930, the Department of Highways, State of
Pennsylvania opened three ditches into the lands of the petitioner to drain
the said Highway and that by the construction of said Highway turned large
quantities of water which collected on said Highway into said drains or
ditches. That by reason of said water being turned into said ditches, the
land of your petitioner was washed so that a large part of the surface of
said land was carried away and the ditches were washed to such an extent
that it was impossible to farm over them whereby one of the fields of your
petitioner is cut into four sections.

Your petitioner therefore prays the Honorable Court to appoint
viewers, under and in pursuance of the State Highway Act approved April
29th, 1925, and as amended by the Act of April 10th, 1929, for the purp-
ose of determining the amount of damages sustained by your petitioner
by reason of the opening, and maintaining such drains or ditches.

And he will ever pray.
