To the Honorable, the Judge of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the Permanent Board of Viewwrs of Cambria County, appointed by your honorable Court upon the attached order and therein directed to view and determine the damages, if any, which have been sustained or which seem likely to be sustained by Laura J. Noel, life tenant, by reason of the change of grade and widening of the public highway leading from the village of Malister northward through and over the premises of said life tenant of the township of Munster, Cambria County Pennsylvania, respectfully report:

That having given notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers to the Commissioners of Cambria County and to the said petitioners by serving written notice upon them according to law and to the general public by posting printed hand bills on the premises as provided by the rules of Court, a copy of which notice is hereto attached:

All of us met upon the premises in accord with the notices served and posted as aforesaid, together with the attorney for the petitioner, a representative of the State Highway Department, and a representative of the Commissioners of the County of Cambria and together with them having gone over and viewed the premises and the improvements on said highway where it crosses the same noting the change in the grade and the widening of said road and the manner and the extent to which it effects said farm.

After which examination of the premises we heard the testimony of the parties in interest and their witness had to offer as to the manner and the extent to which the improvements effected said farm and the depreciation of the value of same by reason of the changes in the line and grade of said road; and taking into consideration the advantages and disadvantages resulting and considering the quantity, quality and value of the premises so effected we have estimated and

determined that the petitioner has sustained damages in the amount herein after noted. For following reasons:

That the public road has been widened and elevated between the house and barn in such manner as to increase the distance to be traveled in going from either to the other probably thirty or more yards.

That by reason of the new elevation it had been made much more difficult to drive from and to the barn from the public highway by making the angle turning on to the from the public road more acute.

That by reason of change in width and elevation the approach to the public road will in all events be required to be shifted almost to the property line of the farm and in order so to do it will be necessary, both for safety and convenience to move or tear down a wagon or machine shed to the expense and detriment of the petitioners.

That by reason of said elevating and widening of the public road directly opposite the approach to the barn floor it has so shortened the distance between the read and barn, which before was limited, as to make it very difficult to turn and drive onto the barn floor with a load of hay or grain,

That the distance between the barn floor and the right of way, which has been widened towards the barn and the elevation of which has been increased, so as to make it impractible to drive onto the barn floor and will make it very inconvenient and difficult to unload hay or grain with hay fork, such as is ordinarly used by farmers for that purpose, and these together with other minor effects upon the premises in question; and definately described on the attached order; we have estimated and determined that the petitioner is entitled to damages.

Hence we recommend that the County of Cambria should pay the said Laura J. Noel or parties in interest the sum of day fundred, fifty - " Dollars damages. (650.")

Unless exceptions are filed ora an appeal taken from the above award within thirty days from the filing hereof the same shall be confimmed absolutely.

It has been agreed by the attorney for the petitioner and the Commissioners of Cambria County that no exceptions to this report will be taken on account of attaching no draft and no sitting on part of the viewers to exhibit a schedule of the award of benefits and damages.
