To the Honorable the Judges of the above named Court:

The petition of John A. Satzinger and A. M. Adams respectfully
represents:

(1) That they are members of the Board of Supervisors of the Town-
ship of West Taylor, Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

(2) That on the 21st day of July, 1931, the said Board of Super-
visors enacted and passed a Resolution accepting a part of Laura Street in
said Township as a public highway or thoroughfare of said Township, a certi-
fied and attested copy of said Resolution being hereto attached.

(3) That the part of said Laura Street accepted as aforesaid is
more than thirty-three (33) feet in width.

(4) That under the Act of Assembly approved the 22nd day of March,
1927 (P. L. 55), it is necessary that the consent of the Court of Quarter
Sessions of Cambria County, Pa., be given to the acceptance of said street
as a part of the public highway system of said Township.

Wherefore, your petitioners pray that an order and decree be made
by your Honorable Court approving and assenting to the acceptance of said
Laura Street as a public highway of the said Township of West Taylor.

We, the undersigned, being a majority of the members of the Board of Supervisors of West Taylor Township, Cambria County, Pa., do hereby certify that on the 21st day of July, 1931, a Resolution, of which the following is a true copy, was passed at a meeting of said Board:

"Resolved, That Laura Street, beginning at its intersection with the southerly property line of Nathale Street and extending in a northerly direction 420 feet and thence in a northwesterly direction 182 feet to its intersection with the southeasterly property line of Steele Street, with a uniform width of 40 feet for the first mentioned 420 feet and with a uniform width of 33 feet for the remaining 182 feet, as the same is shown on the Doris Plan of Lots, which said Plan is duly recorded in the Recorder's Office of Cambria County, Pa., in Plat Book Vol. 1, page 37, be and the same is hereby accepted as a public highway or thoroughfare of the Township of West Taylor, Cambria County, Pennsylvania".
