

CERTIFIED COPY OF THE RESOLUTION AS ADOPTED  
UNANIMOUSLY -- FULL MEMBERSHIP OF BOARD OF  
SUPERVISORS OF UPPER YODER TOWNSHIP, CAMBRIA  
COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, DULY HELD ON THE 11th  
DAY OF JANUARY, A. D. 1934.

WHEREAS, a petition was presented by all the owners in fee of all the lots abutting on Slagle Street from Valley Pike to Center Street and Center Street from Hill Alley to angle at dividing line between lots Nos. 2 and 3 extended; said streets having been dedicated to public use by plot known as Christian Slagle Plan of Lots as laid out by S. E. Dickey & Company, Civil and Mining Engineers, dated 1 September, 1932, being recorded in the Recorder's office of Cambria County, Pennsylvania, in Plat Book Vol. \_\_\_\_\_, page \_\_\_\_\_; and

Whereas, said petitioners desire that the Township shall accept the said Slagle Street from Valley Pike to Center Street and Center Street from Hill Alley to angle at dividing line between lots Nos. 2 and 3 extended, as public thoroughfares to be incorporated into the system of Township Highways; and

Whereas, all of the abutting owners have executed a release of and from all manner of damages, etc., as attached hereto; and

Whereas, it is the desire of the said supervisors to accept the above described highways as public thoroughfares;

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED, that Slagle Street from Valley Pike to Center Street and Center Street from Hill Alley to angle at dividing line between lots Nos. 2 and 3 extended on the Christian Slagle Plan of Lots aforesaid, be opened and accepted as public thoroughfares or highways of the Township of Upper Yoder, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, as heretofore dedicated to public use on the Plan of Christian Slagle, as laid out by S. E. Dickey & Company, Civil and Mining Engineers, dated 1 September, 1932, and duly recorded in the Recorder's office of Cambria County, Pennsylvania, in Plat Book Vol. \_\_\_\_\_, page \_\_\_\_\_;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the necessary grading and drainage shall be as determined by the Township Engineer;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this action, with the consent of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania, be recorded in the Recorder's office of Cambria County, and then filed with the Clerk of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Slagle Street from Valley Pike to Center Street and Center Street from Hill Alley to angle at dividing line between lots Nos. 2 and 3 extended, as hereinabove described, shall then become a part of the public highway system of the said Township of Upper Yoder, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, and that the costs of these proceedings be paid by the said Township of Upper Yoder, Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

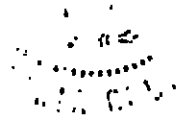

ORDER OF CONFIRMATION

AND NOW, to-wit, this 16<sup>th</sup> day of January, A. D. 1934, the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania, hereby approves and confirms the said Slagle Street from Valley Pike to Center Street and Center Street from Hill Alley to angle at dividing line between lots Nos. 2 and 3 extended on the Christian Slagle Plan of Lots in the Township of Upper Yoder, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, for public use and ORDERS AND DIRECTS that the same be entered of record, and that henceforth the same shall be taken, deeded and allowed to be lawful public streets or highways; and the Court further directs that the said streets shall be opened agreeable to the courses and distances aforesaid, of which the supervisors of the highways of the township through which the said streets pass are to take notice and govern themselves accordingly. The costs of these proceedings to be paid by the Township of Upper Yoder, Cambria County, Pennsylvania.
