TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE ABOVE NAMED COURT:

The petition of the COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF SUMMERHILL, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, respectfully represents:

1. A township road extending through Croyle Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, leads from the Borough of Summerhill to the public highway leading to the Borough of Ebensburg. Said township road is a public highway and has been improved by placing a balcktop road surface over a base of stone. This highway leads from a certain bridge which crosses a small stream or creek which runs between the line of Croyle Township and the line of the Borough of Summerhill.

2. On the opposite side of the bridge extends a public street of the Borough of Summerhill. For many years the traveling public used the said public street of the Borough of Summerhill to the said bridge; thence across said bridge over the stream dividing the Borough of Summerhill from the Township of Croyle; and thence continuing on over the township road which extends through Croyle Township to the Village of New Germany and to other highways leading to Ebensburg, etc.

3. The said public street in the Borough of Summerhill leading to said bridge has been improved and the course thereof changed so that the approach to said bridge will be located a considerable distance up the stream from the present location of the bridge. The work of improving said street was done under the supervision of the Pennsylvania Highway Department and plans for said improvement contemplate a change in the location of the street and also a change in the location of the public highway situate across said stream, so that the approach to said bridge from either side will be located a considerable distance upstream.

4. Arrangements have been made whereby the approaches to said bridge in their new location can be made and as a result of such improvements a new bridge will be required to take the place of the existing bridge; which said bridge shall cross over a creek or stream, and which said bridge shall form a part of the public street of the Borough of Summerhill and part of the public highway in the Township of Croyle.

5. Your petitioners aver that the construction of the bridge to take the place of the existing bridge requires more expense than it is reasonable that the Borough of Summerhill and the Township of Croyle should bear, your petitioners averring that the change of location and the erection of the new bridge will be for the benefit and advantage, not only of the residents of the Borough of Summerhill and the Township of Croyle, but for the benefit of all the traveling public traveling between the Borough of Summerhill, which is located on what is known as the main line improved highway, Route No. 53, to points on the William Penn Highway extending toward the Borough of Ebensburg.

6. Your petitioners aver that in their opinion the improvement will greatly benefit the traveling public, and that the erection of such bridge is necessary to furnish a proper highway across said stream.

WHEREFORE, your petitioners respectfully pray your Honorable Court to appoint viewers who shall report to your Honorable Court as to the necessity for such bridge, and further, as to the propriety of having such bridge entered on record as a county bridge.

REPORT OF VIEWERS

To the Honorable the Judges of the above mentioned
Court.

We the undersigned viewers appointed by the attached order, to view the above mentioned bridge, respectfully report that we have been duly sworn as members of the Permanent Board of Viewers, as shown by the records of the Court; that having given due public notice of said view and of the time and place of meeting by posting notices as required by law in the vicinity of the proposed site of the bridge and by service of such notice on the County Commissioners of Cambria County, the Council and Burgess of the Borough of Summerhill and the Supervisors of the Township of Croyle, as shown by copies and acceptance of said notices hereto attached; we met in accordance with the notice given on the 14th day of May A. D. 1935 at 10:00 o'clock A. M. (eastern standard time) and proceeded with the duties of our appointment; we viewed the old bridge to be vacated and the premises and proposed site for the proposed new bridge; we find that by reason of the construction of State Highway Route 11025 by the Department of Highways of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, making same a through traffic route from Summerhill to Ebensburg, that on account of abrupt curves and grades it is necessary to change the location of the old bridge to conform with the relocation of said route 11025; that we are of the opinion that said change of location was necessary and that said change, regardless of the unsafe condition of the old bridge, constitutes a necessity for a new bridge at this site. During the view we observed that some work in connection with the construction of this new bridge has been executed and were informed that an L. W. D. project had been

filed and approved for this bridge and work started thereunder, but discontinued on account of the inability of the Borough of Summerhill and the Township of Croyle to raise sufficient funds to buy the supplies and rentals to be furnished by them under the L. W. D. project. That we are of the opinion that said new bridge is necessary, therefore, we proceeded to lay out said bridge, having due respect for the shortest distance and the best ground for same and in such manner as would be as near as practicable to the desire of the petitioners and at the same time do the least injury to private property.

A plot or draft showing the location of the proposed bridge, the old bridge to be vacated, the section of old road to be vacated and the section of new road to be acquired, is hereto attached and made a part of this report and herewith returned for public use, which shows said bridge and section of new road required, as follows; said bridge is located at a point on Laurel Run northwardly a distance of 332.00 feet or at State Highway station 642 + 32 measured along the center line of Route 11025 from the center of the driveway to the property of A. J. Wess. Section of highway to be supplied, beginning at a point measured along the center line of said Route 11025, N. 2° 45' E. 202.66 feet from the center line of driveway to the property of A. J. Wess at State Highway station 641 + 02.66 the point of a 10 degree curve to the left having an angle of 34° 48' with a radius of 573.69 feet, thence by said curve in a northerly direction a distance of 348.00 feet to State Highway station 644 + 50.66 the place of ending; Said portion of highway to be vacated is shown in red and said portion to be supplied is shown in green on plan attached hereto.

The approaches and site of the proposed new bridge and the section of new highway required will occupy private property.

We are informed that Deeds of Release and Quit Claim have been obtained by the Department of Highways of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, therefore, we assess no benefits and no damages to Steven Wess, Norman Betz, F. Hoover, W. R. Kirby and Ed. Bodenschatz, abutting property owners.

During the view several citizens of the aforesaid Borough and Township, the officials of the Borough of Summerhill and the Supervisors of the Township of Croyle were present and heard. We have estimated that the total cost of a new county bridge at this location will approximate \$3300.00. We have also estimated that in addition to the work already executed and the steel beams furnished by Cambria County now at the site of the work, that the cost of the remaining material to be appropriated and supplied to complete this bridge under the original L. W. D. project, which is still available, will be approximately \$650.00. We find that the erection of the new bridge and the finishing of the additional appropriation would be burdensome upon the taxpayers and more than they reasonably should bear.

After considering all the matters before us, we are of the opinion that said section of highway should be vacated and said new section supplied, and that a new bridge is necessary for the traveling public and that the prayer of the petitioners should be granted. We further recommend that this bridge should be finished as an L. W. D. project with County Aid, that is, the County of Cambria to appropriate \$650.00 for the additional material required, thereby making a County Aid bridge instead of a County bridge.
