TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The petition of the undersigned respectfully represents:

1. That they are Supervisors of Conemaugh Township,  
Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

2. That a public highway in said Township exists and is  
known as Fourth Avenue East, and is being improved to a point  
within the village known as Bon Air.

3. The Supervisors of said Township propose to extend  
said road a distance of four hundred and ninety-six (496) feet  
from the southerly side of East Fifth Street to the northerly  
side of East Sixth Street in the village of Bon Air.

4. A road has been opened by the owners of abutting  
property and the same has been in use for a number of years and  
several dwellings have been erected on the abutting property.

WHEREFORE the Supervisors of Conemaugh Township, showing  
these facts, respectfully pray your Honorable Court for an order  
to permit them to extend that Public Road known as Fourth Avenue  
East from its present terminus at East Fifth Street in the  
village of Bon Air to the northerly side of East Sixth Street  
in said village.

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the abutting property owners and citizens of the Township of Conemaugh have petitioned us, the Conemaugh Township Supervisors, to adopt a certain portion of FOURTH AVENUE EAST, a street or public highway in the said township as a public street or highway, which street or highway was laid out as such on the Plan of Franklin Extended as laid out by the Franklin Land and Improvement Company by S. E. Fetterman, Engineer on the 16th day of June, 1902, said plan being recorded in the Recorder's Office in and for Cambria County in Miscellaneous Book, Volume 10, Page 481; and

WHEREAS, said petitioners and citizens, residing along said street which has never heretofore been accepted by the Township Supervisors, suffer under great inconvenience by reason that the same has never been accepted; and

WHEREAS, it is now the intention and desire of the Supervisors of the said township to accept the hereinafter described portion and/or extension of said FOURTH AVENUE EAST as a public street or highway in pursuance to the Act of General Assembly of 1935, P. L. 1299, Section 1147; 53 P. S. Section 19093-1147, in such case made and provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following portion and/or extension of FOURTH AVENUE EAST be accepted by the Supervisors of Conemaugh Township as a township street and/or highway:

FOURTH AVENUE EAST: Beginning on the southerly side of East Fifth Street to the northerly side of East Sixth Street, in the Village of Bon Air, a distance of four hundred ninety-six (496) feet, more or less.

Motion for adoption of the said portions of street and/or highway made by Frank Slacheta and seconded by Harry Tilley.

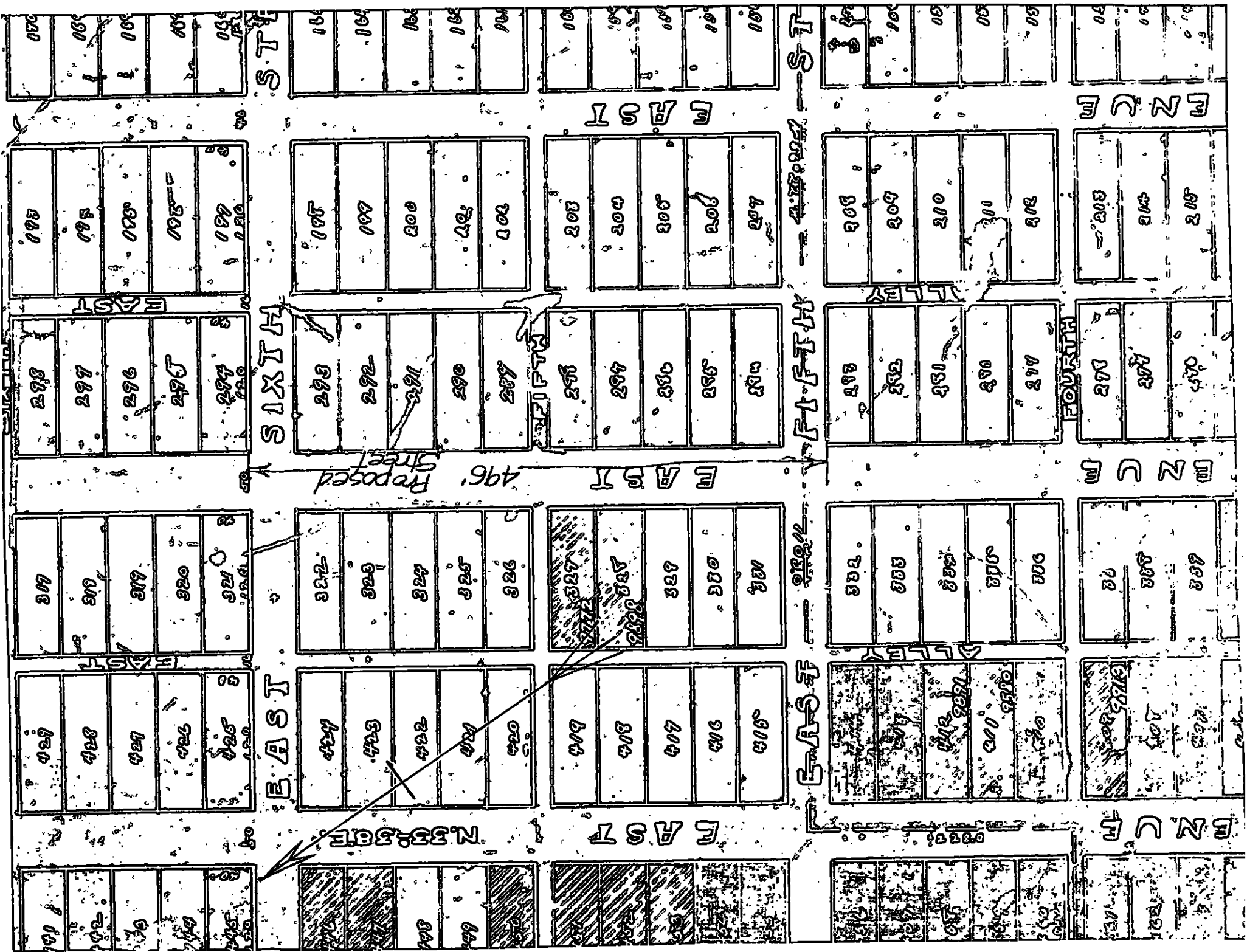
