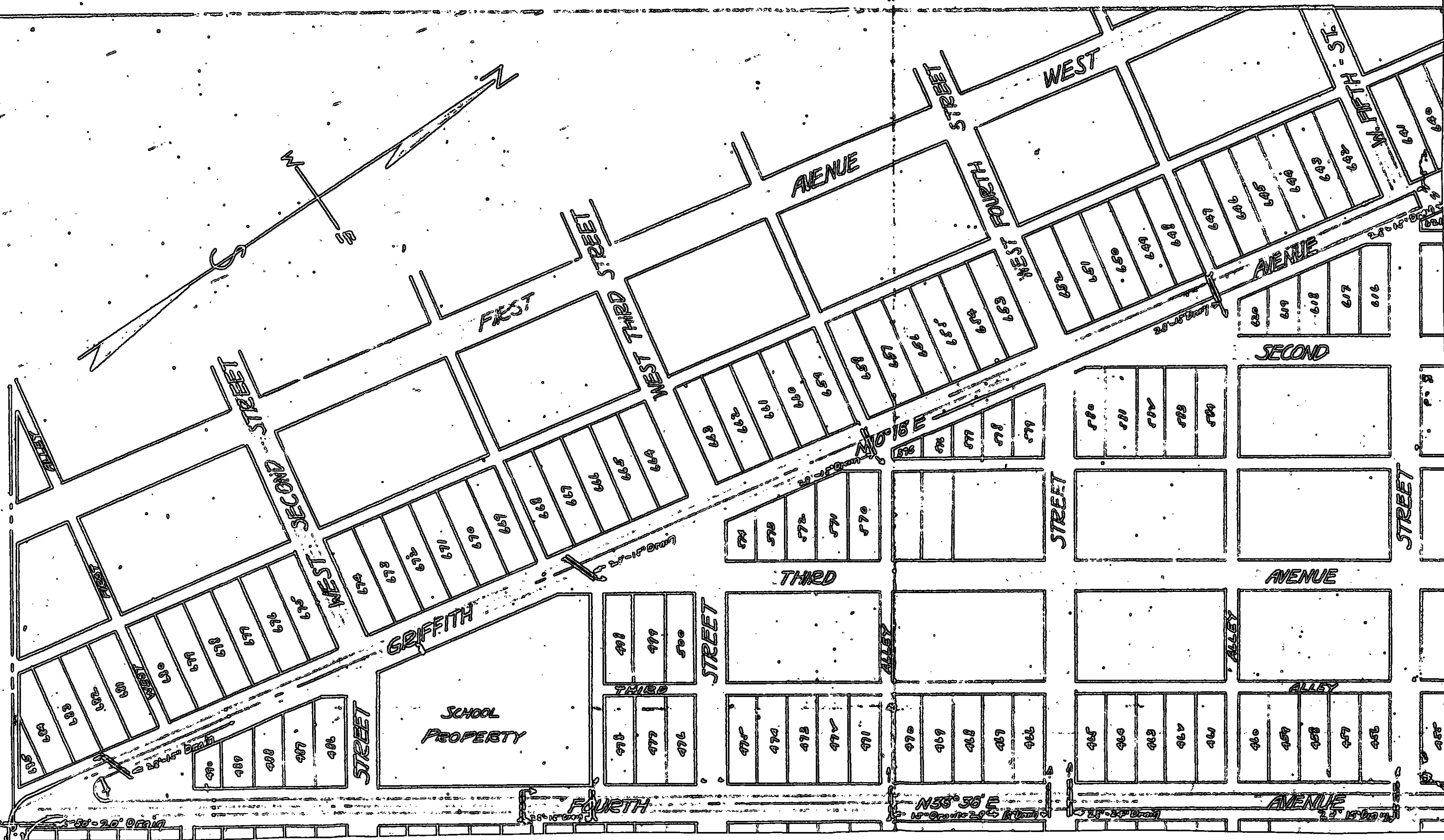

PETITION FOR ACCEPTANCE OF PORTIONS OF WEST FOURTH STREET, EAST
FOURTH STREET, THIRD AVENUE EAST, FIRST AVENUE WEST AND WEST
SECOND STREET AS PUBLIC HIGHWAYS OR STREETS

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE ABOVE NAMED COURT:-

The petition of the BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF CONEMAUGH TOWNSHIP,
CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA respectfully represents:

1. That upon petition of the residents and owners of lots abutting on portions of West Fourth Street, East Fourth Street, Third Avenue East, First Avenue West and West Second Street, streets not heretofore adopted by your petitioners, being dedicated streets in the said Township of Conemaugh and part of the recorded Plan of Franklin Extended, as laid out by the Franklin Land and Improvement Company by S. E. Fetterman, Engineer, January 16, 1902 and recorded in the Recorder's Office of Cambria County in Miscellaneous Book, Volume 10, Page 481, your petitioners accepted the said portions of the said West Fourth Street, East Fourth Street, Third Avenue East, First Avenue West and West Second Street as public streets and/or highways, subject to the consent of this Honorable Court as more fully appears by Resolution of your petitioners hereto attached and made part hereof, marked "Exhibit A".

WHEREFORE, your petitioners respectfully pray that your Honorable Court give its consent to the acceptance of said portions of West Fourth Street, East Fourth Street, Third Avenue East, First Avenue West and West Second Street, described in said Resolution hereto attached, as public highways or streets in the said Township of Conemaugh.

O R D E R

NOW, the 5th day of June, 1939, the within petition having been read and considered, the Court hereby gives its consent that the following portions of WEST FOURTH STREET, EAST FOURTH STREET, THIRD AVENUE EAST, FIRST AVENUE WEST AND WEST SECOND STREET, described in Resolution hereto attached, as "Exhibit A", being dedicated streets on the Plan of Franklin Extended as laid out by the Franklin Land and Improvement Company by S. E. Fetterman, Engineer on January 16, 1902 and said plan having been recorded in the Recorder's Office in and for Cambria County in Miscellaneous Book, Volume 10, Page 481, in Conemaugh Township, Cambria County, be accepted as public highways and/or streets, said streets being described as follows:

1. WEST FOURTH STREET:- Beginning at the western intersection of said West Fourth Street and First Avenue West; thence in an easterly direction to the west intersection of said West Fourth Street and Griffith Avenue, a distance of three hundred sixty-six (366) feet, more or less.
2. EAST FOURTH STREET:- Beginning at the west intersection of said East Fourth Street and Griffith Avenue; thence through Griffith Avenue and through Third Avenue East to the east intersection of said East Fourth Street and Fourth Avenue East, a distance of seven hundred thirty-six and forty-nine one-hundredths (736.49) feet, more or less.
3. THIRD AVENUE EAST:- Beginning at the southern intersection of said Third Avenue East with Griffith Street; thence northeastwardly through East Third Street to the northern intersection of Third Avenue East and East Fourth Street, a distance of five hundred eighty-six (586) feet, more or less.

4. FIRST AVENUE WEST:- Beginning at the southern intersection of First Avenue West with West Second Street, thence northwardly through West Third Street and West Fourth Street to the northerly intersection of West Fifth Street with First Avenue West, a distance of one thousand five hundred twenty-eight (1528) feet, more or less.

5. WEST SECOND STREET:- Beginning at the western intersection of West Second Street with First Avenue West, thence in an easterly direction to the eastward intersection of said West Second Street with Griffith Avenue, a distance of four hundred sixteen (416) feet, more or less.

And it is further ordered and directed that the said portions of West Fourth Street, East Fourth Street, Third Avenue East, First Avenue West and West Second Street forthwith be and become a part of the highway system of the Township of Conemaugh, Cambria County, and be it still further ordered and directed that this proceeding be recorded in the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

"EXHIBIT A"

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the abutting property owners and citizens of the Township of Conemaugh have petitioned us, the Conemaugh Township Supervisors, to adopt certain portions of streets and/or public highways in said township as public roads; said streets and/or highways having been laid out as streets on the Plan of Franklin Extended, as laid out by the Franklin Land and Improvement Company by S. E. Fetterman, Engineer, on January 16, 1902 and said plan having been recorded in the Recorder's Office in and for Cambria County in Miscellaneous Book, Volume 10, Page 481; and

WHEREAS, said petitioners and citizens of the Township of Conemaugh, residing on said portions of streets and/or highways which have heretofore never been accepted by the Township Supervisors suffer under great inconvenience by reason that the same has never been accepted as public streets and/or highways by the Supervisors of Conemaugh Township; and

WHEREAS, it is now the intention and desire of the Supervisors of the said Conemaugh Township to accept the hereinafter described portions of said streets known as West Fourth Street, East Fourth Street, Third Avenue East, First Avenue West and West Second Street as public streets and/or highways, in pursuance to the Act of Assembly of 1935, P. L. 1299, Section 1147; 53 P. S. Section 19093-1147, in such case made and provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following portions of the said West Fourth Street, East Fourth Street, Third Avenue East, First Avenue West and West Second Street be accepted by the Supervisors of Conemaugh Township as township streets and/or highways:

1. WEST FOURTH STREET:- Beginning at the western intersection of said West Fourth Street and First Avenue West; thence in an easterly direction to the west intersection of said West Fourth Street and Griffith Avenue, a distance of three hundred sixty-six (366) feet, more or less.

2. EAST FOURTH STREET:- Beginning at the west intersection of said East Fourth Street and Griffith Avenue; thence through Griffith Avenue and through Third Avenue East to the east intersection of said East Fourth Street and Fourth Avenue East, a distance of seven hundred thirty-six and forty-nine one-hundredths (736.49) feet, more or less.

3. THIRD AVENUE EAST:- Beginning at the southern intersection of said Third Avenue East with Griffith Street; thence northeastwardly through East Third Street to the northern intersection of Third Avenue East and East Fourth Street, a distance of five hundred eighty-six (586) feet, more or less.

4. FIRST AVENUE WEST:- Beginning at the southern intersection of First Avenue West with West Second Street, thence northwardly through West Third Street and West Fourth Street to the northerly intersection of West Fifth Street with First Avenue West, a distance of one thousand five hundred twenty-eight (1528) feet, more or less.

5. WEST SECOND STREET:- Beginning at the western intersection of West Second Street with First Avenue West, thence in an easterly direction to the eastward intersection of said West Second Street with Griffith Avenue, a distance of four hundred sixteen (416) feet, more or less.

Motion for adoption of the said portions of streets and/or highways made by Harry Tilley and seconded by Frank Sluhts.
