D. 1929, before the Honorable Judge of the said Court: Upon the petition of divers inhabitants of the Township of Washington, in the said County, setting forth that they labor under inconvenience for want of a public road or highway, to lead from beginning at a point on the said Township Road leading from Lilly Borough to State Highway Route #22 in the said Township of Washington, at a point where the State Highway intersects with a private road; thence along said private road a distance of two hundred fifty (250) feet more or less; thence in an easterly direction a distance of thirteen hundred (1300) feet more or less, to land of Reade Estate.

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. The Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

L. E. Kaylor

surveyor, and

James McCann and A. M. Shoemaker

viewers, to view the ground proposed for said road, and if they view the same, and shall agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be as far as practicable, agreeable to the desires of the petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which it may pass.

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

REPORT OF VIEWERS.

To the Honorable, the Judges of the above named Court, we , the under-  
signed viewers, appointed by the annexed order of the Court to view  
the proposed location for a new Public Road, as indicated by the an-  
nexed order of Court, respectfully report;

That we have been duly sworn as members of the Permanent Board of Viewers  
for Cambria County and that after having given due public notice, as  
required by law, by posting notices , hereto attached and made a part of  
this report, and serving same on the Commissioners of cambria County and  
on the Supervisors of Washington Township, also hereto attached;

That we met on the site of the proposed new road on the morning of July  
22nd., at ten o'clock, as per notices attached, and proceeded to perform  
the duties of our appointment.

The Supervisors of Washington Township were in attendance, also the  
residents of the district to be served by the road and there was complete  
agreement hat the proposed new road should be granted. We, the viewers,  
were unanimous in the same opinion and granted the road and proceeded  
to lay it out according to these Lines and distances.

Lines and distances

" Beginning at a point on the Township Road leading from the Borough of  
Lilly, as indicated by the order of the Court attached hereto, thence along  
the township road South 67 degrees 00 West ~~140~~ hundred forty feet, thence  
through and over lands of John Clynemeyer , Michael Andrews, John Kuntz(  
(late of Joseph Congo deed) and Mike Drevenek south 85 de, grees 05' East  
507.6 feet ( five hundred seven and six tenth feet) to a point on a ded-  
icated street; thence along said street North 65 degrees 00' East a  
distance of twelve hundred fifty-four feet (1254.6 ) to line of property  
of the Reade Estate.

The viewers awarded damages to Mike Drevenek in the sum of fifty dollars, (\$50.00) for strip of ground required for the new road, and a like amount each to Clynemeyer, Andrews and Kuntz. Owing to the fact that the traffic in this district will be the minimum the viewers recommend that the width of the new road should be the minimum acceptable to the authorities. After careful consideration of the entire situation and the facts before us, we the viewers are of the opinion that the road, as laid out by us, and according to the grades and distances prescribed on the accompanying maps is a necessity to these property owners and we respectfully recommend that the prayer of the petitioners be granted.

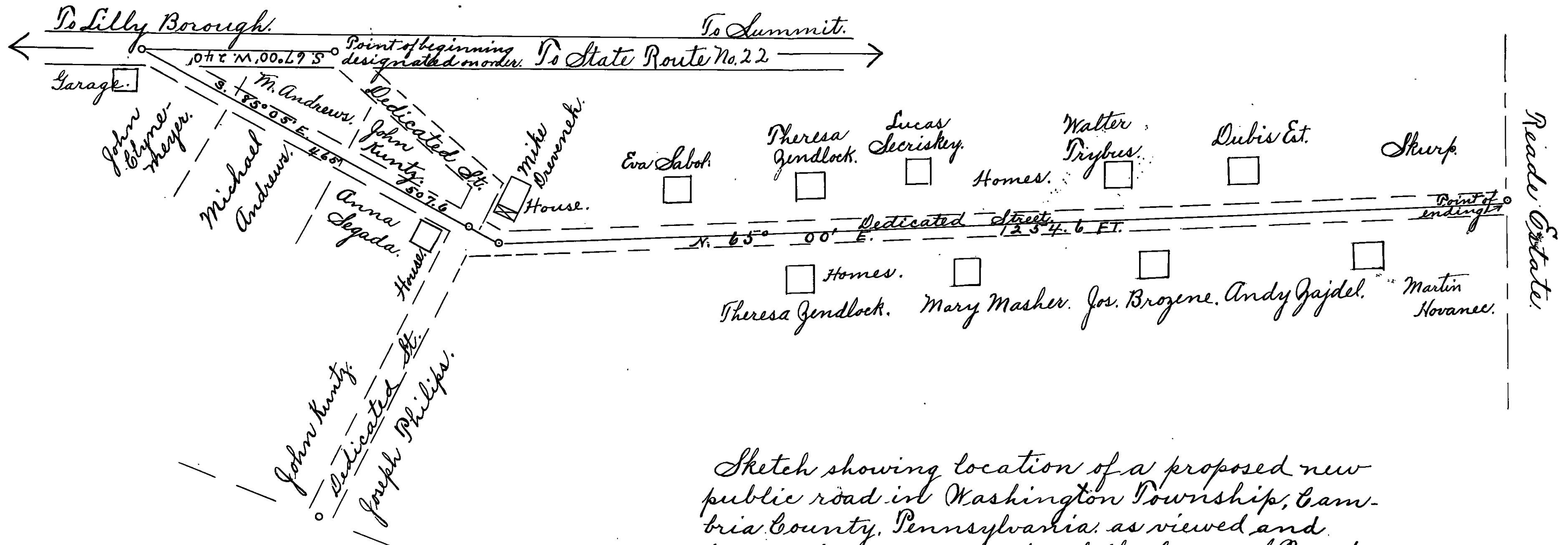
