REPORT OF VILUERS.

To the Honorable, the Judges of the above named Court, we, the undersigned viewers, appointed by the annexed order of the Court to view the proposed location for a new Public Road, as indicated by the annexed order of Court, respectfully report;

That we have been duly sworn as members of the Permanent Board of Viewers for Cambria County and that after having given due public notice, as required by law, by posting notices, hereto attached and made a part of this report, and serving same on the Commissioners of cambria County and on the Supervisors of Vashington Township, also hereto attached; That we met on the site of the proposed new road on the morning of July 22nd., at ten o'clock, as per notices attached, and proceeded to perform the duties of our appointment.
