

NOW THE CONDITION OF THIS OBLIGATION IS SUCH that if the above bounden AMErry and Confranchart. their heirs, executors, or administrators, or any of them, shall and do well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said County of Cambria a sufficient sum to pay for the purpose of viewing the above mentioned road, if the Court shall so direct, when the same is concluded, then this obligation to be void or else remain in full force and effect.
