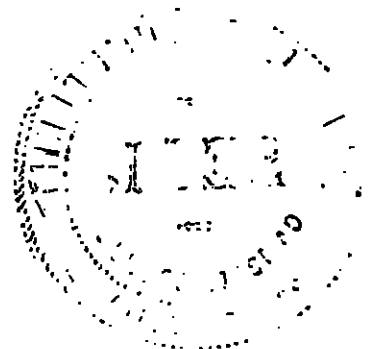

breadth of forty feet, which said road so reported, approved for public use, confirmed and

Report H Penn the Reminded

R E P O R T O F V I E W E R S .

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of
Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the Permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County, appointed by your Honorable Court; upon the attached order, and therein directed to view and determine as to the necessity for a public road between the termini therein specified respectfully report:

That having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers to the Commissioners of Cambria County and to the Supervisors of the Township of Summerhill, and having them accept service of notices hereto attached, and to the traveling public by printed hand bills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the termini and along the route of the proposed new road; All of us met at the time and place appointed, after having been each first duly sworn according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and according to the best of our judgment and ability, and having gone over and carefully viewed the situation and the location suggested for the proposed new road; we are all of the opinion that the new road as prayed for by the petitioners is necessary for the convenience and accommodation of the public and especially those residing in the vicinity of the village of Beaverdale.

The suggested new road as laid out and recommended; a plot or draft of which is hereto attached and made a part of this report; takes the following courses and distances, viz: Beginning in the Village of Beaverdale, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, at the juncture of Howard Avenue (an improved dedicated street) with Cedar Street and extending thence along said Howard Avenue; north eighty two degrees fifteen minutes east four hundred ninety and seven tenth feet to the westerly side of Beaver Run, thence crossing said Beaver Run north sixty seven degrees thirty minutes east one hundred fifty seven and five tenth feet, to the community recreation park; thence

north fifty nine degrees east one hundred seventy eight and five tenth feet; thence north eighty six degrees thirty minutes east one hundred eighty and six tenth feet; thence north seventy eight degrees east four hundred nine feet; and north fifty nine degrees east two hundred ninety four feet to a point, in said township of Summerhill, on Pearley Street opposite the residence of one Joseph Slifko, the place of ending designated in the attached order.

No damages being sustained, we award no damages.

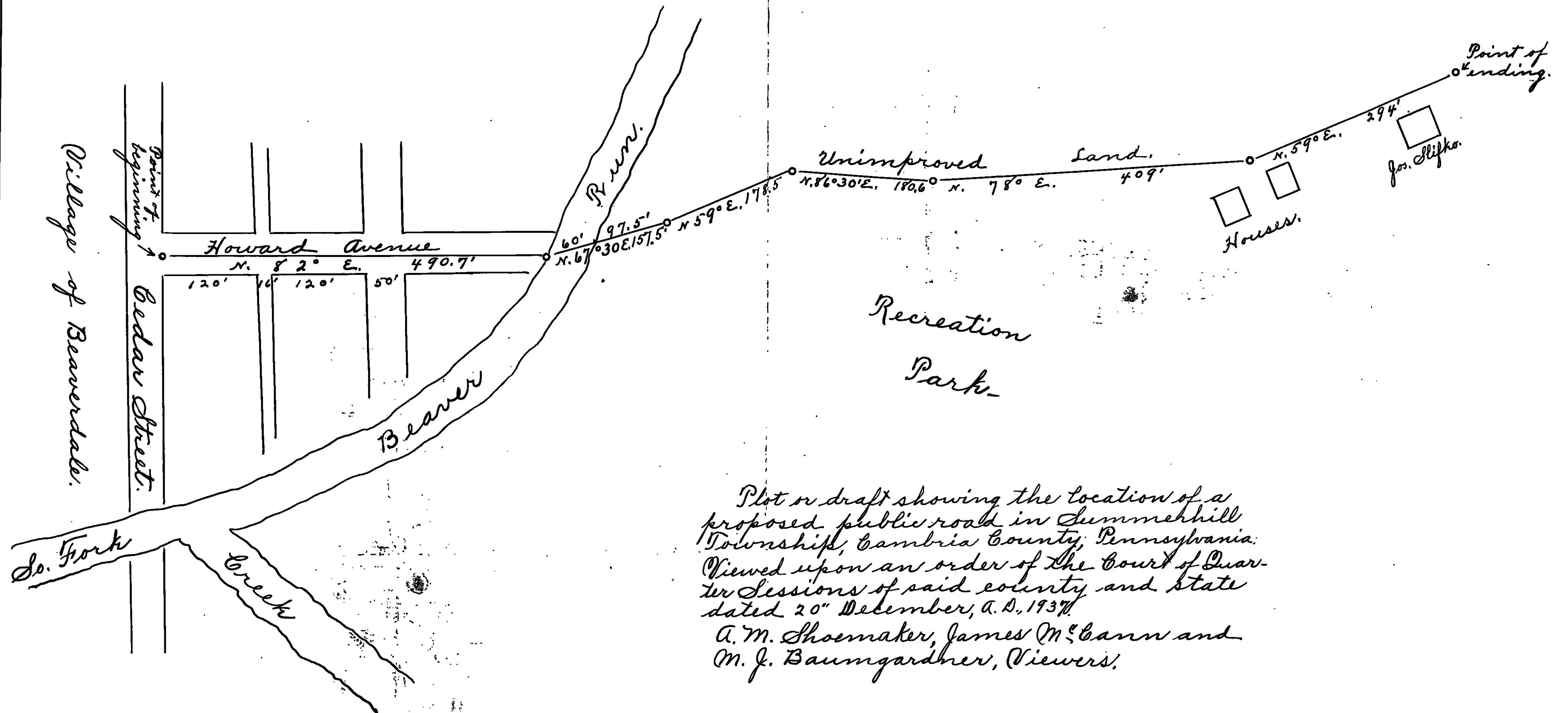
