1. That at a Special Meeting of the Board of Road Supervisors of the Township of Richland held on the 25th day of September, A.D., 1939, a resolution was adopted by the said Board of Road Supervisors to take over as a township road, subject to the approval of the Court of Quarter Sessions, a certain section or piece of road or street located in the Cornelia Park Plan of Lots situate in the Plan of Johnstown Heights in Richland Township.

That the section or piece of road or street which is to be taken over by the Township of Richland is fully described in the resolution of the Board of Road Supervisors which is entered in the Minute Book of the said Board of Road Supervisors. A certified and attested copy of the said resolution is attached hereto, made a part hereof, and marked "Exhibit 1", and a map of the proposed highway is attached and marked "Exhibit 2".

That the Board of Road Supervisors of Richland Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, accept as a public highway that section of road located in the CORNELIA PARK, formerly JOHNSTOWN HEIGHTS, section of the said Township of Richland, beginning at the intersection of Cherry Avenue and John Street on the CORNELIA PARK Plan of Lots situate in the Plan of JOHNSTOWN HEIGHTS; thence in an easterly direction, along John Street, a distance of eight hundred fifty (850) feet, to the intersection of the said John Street and Euclid Avenue on the said Plan of Johnstown Heights; said street or road being properly dedicated on the Plan of Johnstown Heights laid out by Geo. S. Gore and J.W.Wirt on the 5th day of September, 1914, O.P. Thomas, C.E., and recorded on the 28th day of July, 1927, in the office of the Recorder of Deeds in and for Cambria County, Pennsylvania, in Plat Book Vol. 3, at Page 23. The said street or road which is hereby accepted by the said Township of Richland as a public highway having a width of thirty-eight (38) feet.
