ACCEPTANCE OF CERTAIN STREETS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF PORTAGE, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, WHICH HAVE BEEN DEDICATED TO PUBLIC USE BY PLOTS DULY RECORDED IN THE OFFICE OF THE RECORDER OF DEEDS OF SAID COUNTY.

WHEREAS, a large body of citizens, residents of the Township of Portage, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, have made application to the Supervisors of said Township to accept certain streets in said Township which have been dedicated to public use by plots duly recorded in the Recorder's Office of Cambria County, and make them a part of the highway system of said Township.

WHEREAS, the Township Supervisors are of the opinion that the residents and taxpayers along such streets are entitled to the accommodation and convenience which a maintained highway would afford:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that we, the corporate authorities of the Township of Portage, County of Cambria, and State of Pennsylvania, accept as public roads of the Township of Portage those certain streets of the plots hereinafter mentioned, described as follows:

Wayne Street between Center Street and Maine Street a distance of approximately 600 feet; Cambria Street between Wayne Street and the Portage Borough boundary line a distance of approximately 300 feet; Luther Street between Beaverdale Road and Maine Street a distance of approximately 900 feet; Knox Avenue between Maine Street and Kent Street a distance of approximately 550 feet; Kent Street between Knox Avenue and Wesley Avenue a distance of approximately 350 feet; all said streets being marked on the plot of lots laid out by the Martin Realty Company, which is recorded in the Recorder's Office of Cambria County, Pennsylvania, in Plat Book No. 1 at Page 151.

Also McGough Street between Front Avenue and the Right of Way of the old Portage Railroad a distance of approximately 800 feet as shown on the plot of lots laid out by P. J. Little and recorded in the Recorder's Office of Cambria County in Plat Book No. 1 at Page 151.

Also Martin Street between King Street and Storm Street a distance of approximately 320 feet; King Street between Martin Avenue and Fraser Avenue a distance of approximately 320 feet; Fraser Avenue between King Street and Sonman Street a distance of approximately 720 feet; Storm Street between Martin Avenue and Fraser Avenue a distance of approximately 320 feet; Sonman Street between Fraser Avenue and Martin Avenue a distance of approximately 420 feet; each as shown on the plot of lots as laid out by J. C. Martin, recorded in the Recorder's Office of Cambria County in Plat Book No. 1 at Page 44.

Also Gillespie Avenue between Caldwell Avenue and the Portage Borough Line, a distance of approximately 500 feet, as shown on the plot of lots known as Hammer's Addition No. 2, revised, to Portage, as recorded in the Recorder's Office of Cambria County in Plat Book No. 1 at Page 173.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said Streets be accepted as a part of the public highway system of said Township only for road purposes, and it is not intended that the Township assume any responsibility for the construction or maintenance of any sidewalks along said streets and avenues.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary is hereby instructed to file with the Clerk of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County a certified and attested copy of this Resolution, in accordance with the Act of Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, approved the 13th day of May A. D. 1925, P. L. 673.
