- l. That said Report of the Board of Viewers is defective for the reason that it fails to set forth in brief and concise paragraphic forms all Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.
- 2. That said Report of the Board of Viewers is defective for the reason that it fails to have filed with it a map or plan showing the property reportedly damaged by the change of grade.
- Award of Damages are null and void and of no effect whatsoever for the reason that the Court of Common Pleas has exclusive jurisdiction in proceedings brought by an owner of property in a Borough, seeking an award of damages for a change in grade of an adjoining road against a Borough, and these proceedings have been brought in the Court of Quarter Sessions.

- Award of Damages are null and void for the reason that the records do not indicate that the Viewers were duly sworn in the manner required by law, namely, P. L. 1621, Section 43, as amended on the 10th day of July, 1947.
