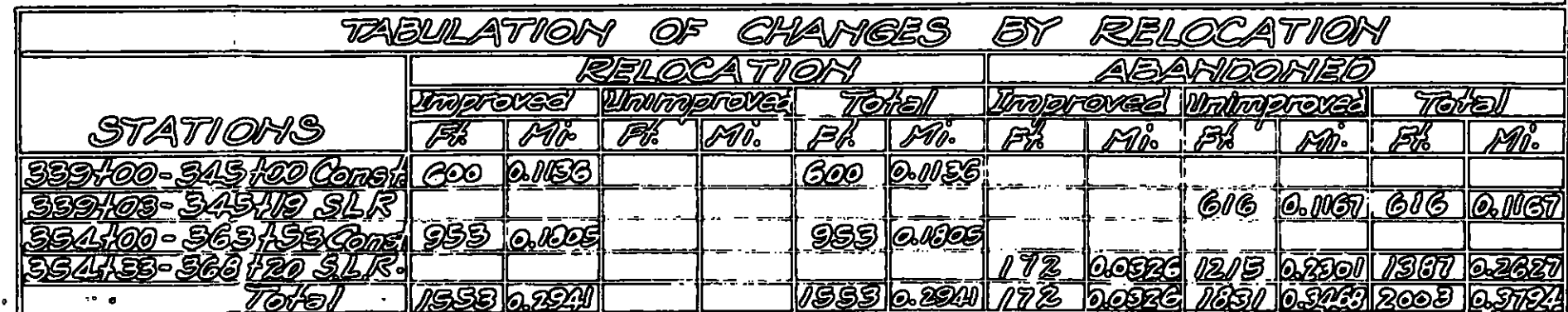

visors of the Township of West Carroll, County of Cambria, and State of  
Pennsylvania, hereby make the following report:

That they are the duly elected, qualified and active supervisors  
of the said Township of West Carroll.

That two portions of Route 11054, Section 1, in said Township  
of West Carroll, are more particularly described as follows:

'Beginning at State Highway Station 339 + 03 on State  
Highway Route No. 11054; thence following the old  
or abandoned portion of said Route No. 11054, a  
distance of 616 feet or 0.1167 miles to State High-  
way Station 345 + 19."

'Beginning at State Highway Station 354 + 33 on State  
Highway Route No. 11054; thence following the old  
or abandoned portion of said Route No. 11054, a  
distance of 1387 feet or 0.2627 miles to State High-  
way Station 368 + 20."

That it is desired to vacate two portions of said roadway be-  
cause of public convenience. That a copy of a survey of the said portions of  
roadway is hereby attached, marked Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof.

That the owners of real estate affected by the abandonment and  
vacating of said Route 11054, Section 1, are listed as follows: Peter Inzana,

John Kovall, Angelo Crimaldi, Rose Crimaldi, Sterling Coal Company and Frank Wood.

That the above named persons were each served on the 21st day of March, 1953, with written notice to the effect that the Supervisors of said Township of West Carroll, would hold a meeting on the 4th day of April, 1953 at 9:00 o'clock A. M. at Bakerton Public School House at Bakerton, Pa., to consider the matter of vacating portions of the said Route 11054. The Notices together with the serveral Acceptances of Service are hereto attached marked Exhibits "B", "C", "D", "E", and "F", and made a part hereof.

That the Township of West Carroll was released and forever discharged from any and all claims to damages caused by said vacation of two portions of Route 11054 as is shown by the written release of damages sealed and filed by the aforesaid owners of the real estate. Said Release of Damages is hereto attached, marked Exhibit "G" and made a part hereof.

That pursuant to said notice, the Supervisors of the said Township of West Carroll held the said meeting at the time and place aforesaid at which meeting the said supervisors, in the interest of public convenience, passed an ordinance vacating the two portions of the said Route 11054. Certified copy of the said ordinance is hereto attached, marked Exhibit "H" and made a part hereof.

ORDINANCE NO. 2

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE A PORTION  
OF  
STATE HIGHWAY ROUTE 11054 SECTION  
NO. 1

WHEREAS, State Highway Route 11054, Section 1, is a part of the road system of West Carroll Township.

WHEREAS, Route No. 11054, Section 1, was abandoned by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as part of the State Highway System because of relocation and construction of a new portion of said State Highway Route No. 11054 by the Department of Highways and is not necessary or needed as a township road, and, in the interest of public convenience, the said supervisors have decided to vacate, by ordinance, the said Route 11054, herein described.

NOW THEREFORE, Be It Ordained and enacted by the Supervisors of West Carroll Township, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

SECTION 1.

THAT in the judgment of the Supervisors, for and in the interest of public convenience, the following described roads be and the same are hereby vacated:

BEGINNING at State Highway Station 339  $\pm$  03 on State Highway Route No. 11054; thence following the old or abandoned portion of said Route 11054 a distance of 616 feet or 0.1167 miles to State Highway Station 345  $\pm$  19.

BEGINNING at State Highway Station 354  $\pm$  33 on State Highway Route No. 11054; thence following the old or abandoned portion of said Route 11054 a distance of 1387 feet or 0.2627 miles to State Highway Station 368  $\pm$  20.

SECTION 2.

THAT the Township Solicitor be and hereby is authorized and di-

rected to file a certified copy of the Ordinance in the office of the Clerk of Courts of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, State of Pennsylvania, together with the name of the owners of property affected, a draft and survey of the road vacated, and a report of the proceedings relating to the vacation of the road hereinabove described.

SECTION 3.

ALL ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
