TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE ABOVE NAMED COURT:

The petition of the Supervisors of the Township of West Carroll,

County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, set forth the following facts:

-1-

That at a regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of the Township of West Carroll held on the 25th day of July, 1953, a Resolution was adopted by said Board adopting and taking over certain sections of roadway in the Village of Bakerton, Township of West Carroll, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, a certified copy of which Resolution is attached hereto marked Exhibit "1" and made a part hereof.

That the sections of roadway in the Village of Bakerton hereinafter described are shown on the revised plan of lots laid out in the Village of Bakerton as is recorded in the office of the recorder of deeds, etc., in and for the County of Cambria in Plat Book Vol. 4 at page 65, Section 3, being described as follows:

SECTION 1

"Beginning on the southern side of the right of way of the Pennsylvania Railroad and extending for a width of 33 feet along Reed Street to the intersection of Legislative Route No. 11097, otherwise Deveaux Street, with said Reed Street."

SECTION 2

"Beginning on the southern side of Legislative Road No. 11097, formerly Deveaux Street, and extending for a width of 33 feet a distance of approximately 290 feet along Reed Street to the bridge across the West Branch of the Susquehanna River."

A survey showing the above described sections of road, is attached hereto marked Exhibit "2" and made a part hereof.

That the sections of roadway which are to be adopted and taken over by the Supervisors of West Carroll Township are fully described in the above mentioned Resolution adopted by said Supervisors on the 25th day of July, 1953:

WHEREFORE, the petitioners pray your Honorable Court to consent to the taking over and adopting of the said roadway as a township road, under the provisions of Section 1147 of the Act of July 18, A. D., 1935, P.L. 1299 as amended, (Section 17, Act of July 10, 1947, P.L. 1481), in order that such roadway shall be and become a part of the public highway system of the Township of West Carroll.
