L. 590, subject to the consent of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.
- That attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A" and made part hereof, is a certified copy of the resolution of the Board of Supervisors of said Township of Susquehanna, adopted Way 4 1954, by unanimous vote of the said Supervisors, duly recorded and entered upon the minutes of said Board of Supervisors.
