RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT CERTAIN DEDICATED STREETS AND ALLEY LAID OUT ON THE REVISED DEVELOP-MENT OF SUBURBAN SHOPS, INC.

WHEREAS, The Suburban Shops, Inc., filed a revised development plan of portions of Ivy Hills, Inc., property situated in Lower Yoder Township, which plan was approved by the City Planning Commission on January 30, 1953, and by the Township of Lower Yoder on January 19, 1953, and which was acknowledged by Stephen J.
