AN ORDINANCE FOR THE ACCEPTANCE, OPENING
AND LAYING OUT OF KENRUTH AVENUE

BE IT ORDAINED, and it is hereby ordained that the Township of Upper Yoder, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, hereby accepts, opens and lays out as a public road in said Township Kenruth Avenue, being 40 feet in width, having a 24 foot roadway and an 8 foot sidewalk on each side, more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at the intersection of the center line of Rosemont Avenue and the center line of Kenruth Avenue at Station 0+0, thence by the center line of said Kenruth Avenue North $79^{\circ} 55'$ West a distance of 274.23 feet to Station 2+74.23, thence by a curve to the left having a radius of 145 feet a distance of 148.34 feet to Station 4+22.57, thence South $41^{\circ} 28'$ West a distance of 274.33 feet to Station 6+96.9 at the intersection of the center line of Goucher Street, the place of ending;

a map, draft and survey showing said Kenruth Avenue and also the center line grade established thereon, as prepared by S. E. Dickey and Company, September 30, 1959, is attached hereto and made a part of this Ordinance.

Ordained and enacted this 2nd day of January 1961.
