## PETITION FOR VACATION

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE ABOVE COURT:

The petition of the Supervisors of the Township of Summerhill, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, respectfully represents:

- 1. That they are the duly elected, qualified and acting supervisors of the Township of Summerhill, a Township of the second class in the County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania.
- 2. That within the above Township, Route No. 748 has been relocated in part by the Department of Highways of the State of Pennsylvania.
- 3. That said relocations, which have occurred from time to time in the past, have resulted in an abandonment of portions of the State Highways above referred to, which abandoned portions appear on the maps attached to this petition and made a part hereof.
- 4. That the abandoned portions of the State Highways above referred to have not been vacated by the Department of Highways of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- 5. That it is in the best interests of the Township of Summer-hill that the said abandoned portions of State Highway Route No. 748 be formally vacated so that there shall be no present or future obligation on the part of the said Township to maintain or repair the same.
- 6. That your petitioners have agreed with the various property owners affected by the proposed vacation that the said portions of Highway may be vacated without the formality of a view, as will appear by reference to the consents which are attached to this petition and made a part hereof.
- 7. That said consents are signed by all of the property owners who would be affected by such vacation.

WHEREFORE, your petitioners under the Act of 1947, P.L. 1481, Section 17, 53 P.S. 19093-1115, pray your Honorable Court for a Decree vacating the portions of State Highway Route No. 748 which were abandoned by relocation of the same and which appear in detail in the maps attached to this petition and made a part hereof.
