ORDINANCE

EXHIBIT A

**AN ORDINANCE FOR THE OPENING AND LAYING OUT
OF DAHLIA STREET AND HAVERFORD STREET.**

WHEREAS, all the owners of property or properties abutting on the aforesaid streets have petitioned, in the interests of public convenience, the Supervisors of Upper Yoder Township, to lay out and open, by Ordinance, roads hereinafter described, now, therefore;

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Supervisors of Upper Yoder Township, and IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the authority of the same,

SECTION 1. That pursuant to the petitions aforesaid, the following described roads be and the same are hereby laid out and opened:

ALL those certain tracts of land situate in the Township of Upper Yoder, County of Cambria, and State of Pennsylvania, being the beds of Dahlia and Haverford Streets and described as follows, are hereby laid out and opened:

BEGINNING at the intersection of the center lines of Dahlia Street and Harshberger Street at Station 0+0, said 0+0 being the dividing line between Southmont Borough and Upper Yoder Township, thence by the center line of said Dahlia Street South 17° - 23' East a distance of 538.96 feet to the Northerly property line of Falcon Avenue at Station 5+38.96.

The center line grade is established as follows:

BEGINNING at Station 0+0 at the center line of Harshberger Street at an elevation of 1686.53, thence descending at the rate of 2.28 feet per hundred feet a distance of 100 feet to Station 1+0 at an elevation of 1684.25, thence descending at the rate of 1.00 feet per hundred feet a distance of 200 feet to Station 3+0 at an elevation of 1682.25, thence descending at the rate of 3.33 feet per hundred feet a distance of 150 feet to Station 4+50 at an elevation of 1677.25, thence descending at the rate of 11.241 feet per hundred feet a distance of 88.96 feet to an elevation of 1687.25 at Station 5+38.96, the Northerly property line of Falcon Avenue, the

place of ending. The street and established grade is shown on the Plan and Profile of Dahlia Street as prepared by S. E. Dickey and Company, Upper Yoder Township Engineers, January 21, 1957.

Description of bed of Haverford Street:

ALL that certain strip or piece of ground situate in Upper Yoder Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, BEGINNING at the center line of Haverford Street at Station 0+0, said Station being on the line dividing Westmont Borough and Upper Yoder Township, thence by the center line of said Haverford Street south 31° 42' East 2043.4 feet to Station 20+43.4, the place of ending. Being shown on the John K. Miller Plan of Lots and also shown on the Plan and Profile of Haverford Street as prepared by Alexander G. Wilson, Jr., R. P. E., May 1958, and approved by T. L. Locher, R. P. E., December 2, 1958. Said Haverford Street being sixty (60) feet in width with eighteen (18) foot sidewalks on each side and a twenty-four (24) foot road way.

The center line grade is hereby established as follows:

BEGINNING at Station 0+0 at an elevation of 1784.2, thence by a vertical curve a distance of 150 feet to Station 1+50 at an elevation of 1780.9, thence descending at the rate of 0.56 feet per 100 feet a distance of 250.0 feet to Station 4+0 at an elevation of 1779.4, thence by a vertical curve a distance of 150 feet to Station 5+50 at an elevation of 1781.8, thence descending at the rate of 3.1 feet per 100 feet a distance of 125 feet to Station 6+75 at an elevation of 1777.9, thence by a vertical curve a distance of 200 feet to Station 8+75 at an elevation of 1773.8, thence descending at the rate of 1.0 feet per 100 feet a distance of 75 feet to Station 9+50 at an elevation of 1773.1, thence by a vertical curve a distance of 150 feet to Station 11+0, at an elevation of 1769.6 thence descending at the rate of 3.6 feet per 100 feet a distance of 175 feet to Station 12+75 at an elevation of 1763.7, thence by a vertical curve a distance of 150 feet to Station 14+25 at an elevation of 1760.0, thence by another vertical curve a distance of 100 feet to Station 15+25 at an elevation of 1757.8, thence descending at the rate of 4.5 feet per 100 feet a distance of 75 feet to Station 16+0 at an elevation of 1754.4, thence by a vertical curve a distance of 150 feet to Station 17+50 at an elevation of 1739.8, thence descending at the rate of 15.0 feet per 100 feet a distance of 50 feet to Station 18+0 at an elevation of 1732.3, thence by a vertical curve a distance of 150 feet to Station 19+50 at an elevation of 1716.9, thence descending at the rate of 5.5 feet per 100 feet a distance of 93.4 feet to Station 20+43.4 at an elevation of 1711.7, the place of ending.

Being shown on the Plan and Profile of Haverford Street as prepared by Alexander G. Wilson, Jr., R. P. E., May 1958, and approved by T. L. Locher, R. P. E., December 2, 1958.

SECTION 2. That the Township of Upper Yoder is authorized and directed to file a certified copy of the Ordinance in the Office of the Clerk of the Quarter Sessions Court, together with the names of the owners of property affected and a draft and survey of the roads.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

ORDAINED AND ENACTED into an Ordinance this 5th day of January, 1959.



DAHLIA STREET


PLAN AND PROFILE








PLATE I-PLAN PROFILE B. R. R. STANDARD
