- 4. That your petitioners have agreed with the property owners affected by such vacation to vacate said parts of said State Highway without the formality of a view, as shown by agreements attached hereto and made a part hereof, being Exhibits A and B.
- 5. That one abandoned portion of said State Highway Route 11054 consists of 882 feet between station 192 + 00 and station 200 + 00, which is shown on Pennsylvania Department of Highway drawing of Route 11054, section 4, which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, and marked Exhibit C.
- 6. The other abandoned portion of said State Highway consists of 2548 feet between Station 86 + 00 and station 109 + 00 all of which is shown on said Department of Highway drawing attached hereto and made part hereof, and marked Exhibit C.


