TO THE HONORABLE JUDGES OF THE ABOVE NAMED COURT.

The petition of the Road Supervisors of Chest Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, respectfully represents:

1. That the Department of Highways of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania have abandoned certain portions of State Highway Route 11054 in Chest Township, Cambria County.

2. That your petitioners deem it advisable to vacate said abandoned portions of said State Highway.

3. That the Department of Highways of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has not vacated these portions of said State Highway.

4. That your petitioners have agreed with the property owners affected by such vacation to vacate said parts of said State Highway without the formality of a view, as shown by agreements attached hereto and made a part hereof, being Exhibits A and B.

5. That one abandoned portion of said State Highway Route 11054 consists of 2122 feet between Station 155 + 00 and Station 175 + 00, as shown on Pennsylvania Department of Highway drawing of Route 11054, Section 4, which is attached hereto and made a part hereof and marked Exhibit "C".

6. The other abandoned portion of said State Highway Route 11054 consists of 826 feet between Station 134 + 00 and Station 142 + 00, all of which is shown on Pennsylvania Department of Highway drawing of Route 11054, Section 4, which is attached hereto and made a part hereof and marked Exhibit "C"

WHEREFORE, your petitioners pray your Honorable Court to approve the vacation of the above described portions of State Highway Route 11054, pursuant to the authority granted to it by the Act of Assembly of 1933, May 1, P.L. 103, Article XI, Section 1115, as amended, 53 Purdons Statutes, Section 66115.




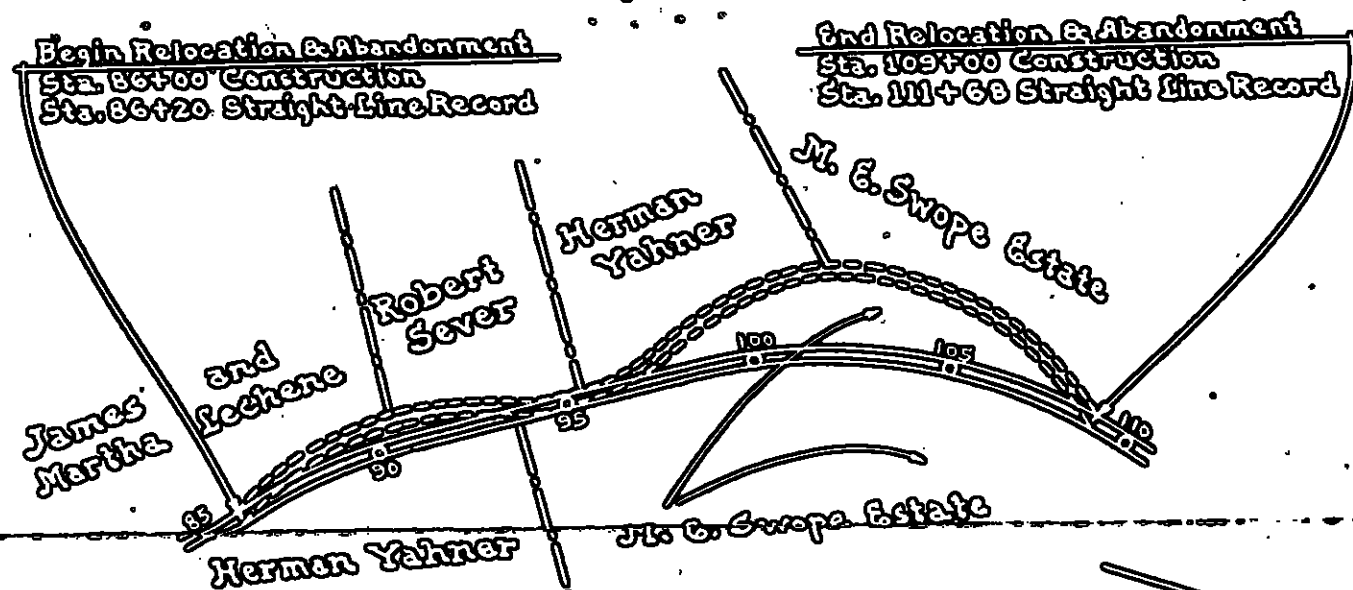
