An Ordinance of the Supervisors of the Township of Marr, Cambria Cambria, State of Pennsylvania, to enact, ordain, survey, lay out, and adopt a certain road as a public road or highway, wholly within the Township, upon petition of a majority in interest, of the oweners of properties upon whose land the road abuts.

WHEREAS, a written petition has been presented to the Supervisors of Barr Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania signed and executed by a majority in interest, of the owners of properties abbuting on a certain private road, hereinafter fully described, situate wholly within the Township of Barr, wherein they allege they are in need of a public highway to replace said private road for the use of themselves, tradesman, doctors and the general public.

AND WHEREAS, said petition respectfully requested the Supervisors that a sutable public highway be enacted, ordained, surveyed, layed out and adopted for said petitioners, in front of their properties now abutting on hereinafter described private road.

AND WEREAS, said petition, duly signed and executed as aforesaid, contained a general release of the Township, of all damages which said petitioners may sustain by reason of the laying out, opening and adopting of said public highway or by the use of any part of their premises for highway purposes.

AND WHEREAS, prior to the passage of this ordinance, the Supervisors of the Township of Barr, gave ten days' written notice to the property owners affected thereby, of the time and place when and where all parties interested may meet and be heard.

AND WHEREAS, said meeting was held on april 6,1959 at 7.00 P.M., at Pfiester's Barber Shop, Nicktown, Pennsylvania, in accordance with the with the written notice given as above set forth, and said meeting was largely attended by persons affected by the laying out and adoption of said private road as a public highway and everybody present was favorable to the proposal and no one offered any objection thereto.

AND WHEREAS, after said hearing held on April 6,1959, and after the Supervisors had fully considered the matter, it was, unanimously agreed by the Supervisors, to exercise the power conferred, and the Supervisors, on the highest of May 1959 will file a copy of this Ordinance together with a draft or survey, of the road, fixing the width thereof and noting the improvements along the lines thereof and names of the owners of property whereon said road shall abut, in the office of the Clerk of Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County in accordance with the Acts of Assembly in such cases made And provided.

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Supervisors of the Township of Barr, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, that the following private road wholly within the Township of Barr, be layed out, opened and adopted as a public road or highway of the Township of Barr—Cambria County, Pennsylvania to a width of sixty feet on St. Joseph's Street, and thirty-three feet on St. Boniface and St. Henry's Streets, which is hereby determined to be sufficient width for public use and travel, which shall not be construed to include the width required for necessary slopes in cuts and fills, when the limits of the road and the extra width required for such slopes exceed the limits of width herein specified.

, Said road or highway is described as follows:

public highway known as Blacklick Street, (Legislative Route 11042) in the center line of St. Joseph Street; thence south seventy degrees center line of St. Joseph Street; thence from a center post in the line of St. Joseph Street; thence from a center post in the line of St. Joseph Street; thence from a center post in the line of St. Joseph Street North nineteen degrees five minutes East three hundred forty-sixeefeet by center line of St. Boniface Street to right of way line of a public highway known as St. Nicholas Street (L.R.11045). as St. Nicholas Street (L.R.11045) in the center line of St. Henry Street; by the center line of St. Henry Street; by the center line of St. Henry Street to the end of the proposed
