RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT A PORTION OF NINTH AVENUE AND A PORTION OF ASH STREET ON THE PARK HILL EAST PLAN OF LOTS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST TAYLOR

WHEREAS, there is filed in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Cambria County the Park Hill East Plan of Lots, which is recorded in Plat Book Vol. 1, Page 90, and also Plat Book Vol. 3, Page 178; and WHEREAS, the said plan shows thereon Beech Street, Ninth

WHEREAS, it is the intention and desire of the Supervisors of the Township of East Taylor, Cambria County, to accept certain portions of Ninth Avenue and Ash Street as shown on the aforesaid dedicated plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township of East Taylor accepts the following streets:

- (1) NINTH AVENUE, beginning at the southeasterly end of Township Route 380, known as Beech Street; thence along Ninth Avenue in a northeasterly direction a distance of 300 feet, it being a 40 foot wide street.
- (2) ASH STREET, beginning at the intersection of Ninth Avenue and Ash Street (where 1 terminates); thence along Ash Street in a northwesterly direction to the intersection of Eighth Avenue and Ash Street, also known as Township Route 736, a distance of 540 feet, it being a 40 foot wide street.
