AN ORDINANCE

ACCEPTING CERTAIN PORTIONS OF GLADSTONE STREET AND GARY STREET IN THE TOWNSHIP OF RICHLAND, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AS TOWNSHIP HIGHWAYS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF VACATING THE SAME.

WHEREAS, a petition signed by University Park Shopping Village, Inc., et al, was presented to the Supervisors of Richland Township requesting the acceptance of certain portions of Gladstone Street and Gary Street in the Township of Richland as Township Highways and releasing the Township of Richland, Cambria County, Pennsylvania from all liability for damages by reason of the enactment and enforcement of legislation in conformity with the prayer of the said petition.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Supervisors of Richland Township that all that portion of the road situate in Richland Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania known as Gladstone Street more particularly described as follows:

Being fifty (50) feet in width and extending from the intersection of said Gladstone Street with Gary Street in an Easterly direction a distance of two hundred fifty (250) feet as shown on the map showing plan for right-of-way of Eisenhower Boulevard and adjoining streets, recorded in the office of the Recorder of Deeds in and for Cambria County on November 2, 1960 in Plat Book Vol. 6, page 29.

and all that portion of the road situate in Richland Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania known as Gary Street more particularly described as follows:

BEING fifty (50) feet in width along Gladstone Street and extending from the intersection of said Gladstone Street with Gary Street in a Southerly direction a distance of five hundred (500) feet to Eisenhower Boulevard, and having a width of one hundred (100) feet along the northerly side of Eisenhower Boulevard

as shown on the map showing Plan for right-of-way of Eisenhower Boulevard and adjoining streets, recorded in the office of the Recorder of Deeds in and for Cambria County on November 2, 1960 in Plat Book Vol. 6, page 29.

be and the same are hereby accepted as Township Highways for the purpose of vacating the same.

In accordance with the petition of University Park Shopping Village Inc. et al, presented to the Supervisors of Richland Township, and in accordance with notice of intention to consider said petition sent by registered mail to Frank H. Ashbridge, United Metal Fabricators, Inc., Claude Nitch, Willard Ripple and Johnstown Sanitary Dairy Company, all the adjoining property owners to said Gladstone Street and Gary Street in Richland Township, that the said petition would be considered at a meeting of the Richland Township Supervisors to be held on June 17, 1963, at 7:30 P.M., D.S.T. at the office of the Supervisors in the Kinamrok Building, 400 Luray Avenue, Richland Township, Johnstown, Pennsylvania and in duly considering the said petition and no objections being made to the said vacation of said sections of Gladstone Street and Gary Street, and it being established that the vacating of the said sections of Gladstone Street and Gary Street would relieve the Township of Richland from the financial liability and legal responsibility and would be a savings to the taxpayers of Richland Township and would not be an inconvenience to the residents of Richland Township and the traveling public and would be a convenience to the adjoining property owners which would result in a benefit to all of the residents of Richland Township,
