Ordinance No. 14

AN ORDINANCE LAYING OUT, OPENING AND ADOPTING AS A PUBLIC STREET IN THE VILLAGE OF TWIN ROCKS, BLACKLICK TOWNSHIP, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, A STREET TO BE DESIGNATED AS SIXTH STREET.

The Township of Blacklick hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. A street, the center line of which is described in Section 2 hereof, is hereby designated as Sixth Street and is hereby laid out, opened and ordained as a public street in the Village of Twin Rocks, Blacklick Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

SECTION 2. The center line of said street hereby ordained is described, in accordance with a print of a survey by L. Robert Kimball, Consulting Engineers, dated July, 1964, attached hereto and made a part hereof, as follows:

Beginning at a railroad spike in the center line of Legislative Route No. 933 in the Village of Twin Rocks, Blacklick Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, as shown on the survey print attached hereto and made a part hereof; thence South $74^{\circ} 42'$ East, a distance of 243.56 feet to a point; thence by a curve to the left having a radius of 127.32 feet, a distance of 115 feet to a point; thence North $53^{\circ} 33'$ East, a distance of 64.17 feet to a point; thence by a curve to the right having a radius of 159.15 feet, a distance of 115.74 feet to a point; thence South $84^{\circ} 47'$ East, a distance of 71.51 feet to a point; thence by a curve to the right having a radius of 381.95 feet, a distance of 250 feet to a point; thence South $54^{\circ} 57'$ East, a distance of 730.30 feet to a point in land of John U. McFadden and Fred J. McFadden and place of ending.

SECTION 3. The width of said street is hereby established and ordained as follows:

(a) Forty (40) feet, being twenty (20) feet on each side of the center line, for that portion of said street from the point of beginning to the westerly line of premises designated as Ebensburg Building and Loan Association on the attached survey print.

(b) Thirty-three (33) feet, being sixteen and one-half ($16\frac{1}{2}$) feet on each side of the center line, throughout the remaining portion of said street.

ENACTED AND ORDAINED into an ordinance, this 6th day of February,

1965.




