AN ORDINANCE FOR THE ACCEPTING, OPENING  
AND LAYING OUT OF KNOX STREET EXTENSION

BE IT ORDAINED, and it is hereby ordained that the Township of Middle Taylor, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, hereby accepts, opens and lays out as public road in said Township Knox Street Extension, being an alley with an average width of 22 feet, with the centerline of said Knox Street Extension beginning at the Southerly line of Knox Street and extending 1045.62 feet by the various courses set forth on the survey made of said Knox Street Extension by Joseph E. Lindsay, P. E., on August 27, 1965, is attached hereto and made part of this Ordinance.
