ORDINANCE NO. 17

AN ORDINANCE LAYING OUT, OPENING AND ADOPTING AS A PUBLIC STREET IN THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST TAYLOR, A STREET TO BE DESIGNATED AS STOMBAUGH AVENUE, AND PIXING AND REGULATING THE WIDTH AND GRADES THEREOF.

BR IT EMACTED AND ORDAINED by the Supervisors of the Township of West Taylor, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same that:

SECTION 1. The following street, which is hereby designated as Stombaugh Avenue, is hereby laid out, opened and ordained as a public street in the Township of West Taylor:

Beginning from the intersection of School Street and Stombaugh

Avenue and extending by center line which is described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the center lines of School Street and Stombaugh Avenue at Station 1+76.07; thence by the center line of Stombaugh Avenue the following courses and distances: South 53° 01' West 173.15 feet to Station 3+49.22; thence South 70° 29' West 129.39 feet to Station 4+78.61; thence South 87° 41' West 81.70 feet to Station 5+60.31, the place of ending.

SECTION 2. The center line grade to be established of said Stombaugh Avenue is as follows:

Beginning at Station 1+76.07 at an elevation of 1006.51; thence ascending at the rate of 0.50 feet per 100 feet a distance of 173.15 feet to Station 3+49.22 at an elevation of 1007.38; thence ascending at the rate of 3.21 feet per 100 feet a distance of 129.39 feet to Station 4+78.61 at an elevation of 1011.53; thence ascending at the rate of 0.634 feet per 100 feet a distance of 81.70 feet to Station 5+60.31 at an elevation of 1012.05, the place of ending.

SECTION 3. The said street shall be 20 feet in width as more fully set forth on Plan and Profile of Minks and Locher Engineers, Inc. dated November 13, 1963 and revised January 12, 1966, Number 5934-I-34.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is enacted pursuant to the Second Class Township Code.

Duly presented and adopted at a regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of the Township of West Taylor, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, held on the 8th day of June, 1966, at which meeting a majority of the members of the Board were present.
