## AN ORDINANCE AND RESOLUTION FOR THE TAKING OVER AND ACCEPTANCE OF DAMIAS DRIVE

BE IT ORDAINED AND RESOLVED, and it is hereby ordained and resolved that the Township of Upper Yodor, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, hereby takes over and accepts as a public road in said Township Damian Drive, being 40 feet in width, excepting that at the end of Damian Drive, where a turnaround, having a radius of 40 feet, is located, the centerline of said Damian Drive is more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at the intersection of the center lines of Damian Drive and Woodmont Road at Station 0+0; thence along the center line of Damian Drive the following courses and distances: South 84° 37' 28" East a distance of 262.48 feet to Station 2+62.483; thence by same and by a curve to the right having a radius of 60 feet an arc distance of 94.25 feet to Station 3+56.73; thence by same South 5° 22' 32' West a distance of 573.69 feet to Station 9+30.42, the place of ending.

A Plan and Profile showing said Damian Drive and also the grade established thereon as prepared by S. E. Dickey and Company on August 39, 1958 is attached hereto and made part of this Ordinance and Resolution.
