## ORDINANCE NO. 4

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF TOWNSHIP ROAD NO. 303 IN ADAMS TOWNSHIP, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

BE IR ORDAINED, and it is hereby ordained by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Adams, Cambria County, Pennsylvania; that 0.9929 miles of Township Road No. 303, extending from its intersection with Township Road No. 300, leading from Krayn to Eureka No. 42, to its intersection with Township Road No. 308, be and the same is hereby abandoned, released and vacated; that public necessity does not require that said road remain open and the public convenience will best be served by vacating the same, and that a map showing the portion of the road to be vacated be made a part hereof and be filed in the office of the Township Secretary, Dunlo, Pennsylvania, where it may be examined by the public.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that a copy of this ordinance be filed in the Office of the Clerk of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania. This ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after its adoption by the Township Supervisors.
