



LR 11135 from Station 0+00 (excluding the 17 foot span bridge and approach area between Stations 103+26.5 and 103+63.5) to Station 127+84, a distance of 12,747 feet or 2.4142 miles.

This action is taken with the concurrence of the Township as evidenced in the attached Resolutions.

As of December 31, 1983, the responsibility for maintenance, construction and reconstruction of the portions of highways described above revert to the Township.
